#### Recruitment Updates

July – 89 randomized; almost all sites contributed, some of the slower sites really stepped up

August (8/14) – 36 randomized

\*SCR to RAN ratio has greatly improved (3.5 study wide)

New Sites (Baltimore, Kaiser, Cleveland) – should begin enrolling in September

#### Combined Screening/Baseline Visit
