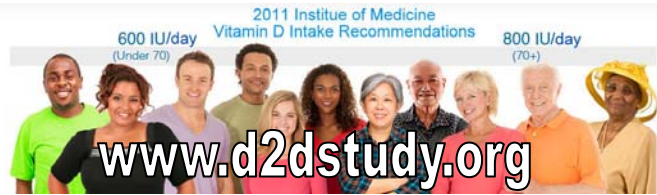


Web Portal Access

The d2dstudy.org website has a restricted access section for members of the D2d study group. Through the portal, qualified users will have access to the Protocol, Manual of Procedures, committee and sub-committee information and other relevant documents. All Investigators and Research Coordinators should request access by following the following steps.

- ✓ Go to www.d2dstudy.org
- ✓ Click the "Login" tab located at the top of the page.
- ✓ Complete the "D2d study web portal access form" by clicking on the link in blue.
- ✓ The CC will review the form and confirm that the user is included on the site Contact Information spreadsheet.
- ✓ Within 2 business days, the user will receive an e-mail confirming that he/she has been granted access and will be provided with a username and password.
