



Medidata Training

1. **Create Login:** Site users who have registered for Medidata EDC access should have received log in information via email. If you have not, first check your spam box then contact the Coordinating Center. If you have not yet requested access, but will need access for data entry or data review, complete the Account Activation Training Form available on the D2d web portal under "Other Documents." Once you receive the email from Medidata, you will be able to create a log in.
2. **eLearning Module:** Upon login on the right side of the screen, the eLearning module "RAVE EDC Essentials," provides a general introduction to Medidata EDC. Modules must be completed by all users to gain access to the live system.
3. **CC Hosted Webinar:** Primary Research Coordinators must attend a webinar (others are welcome) to review D2d specific eCRFs and data management procedures. The webinar will last approximately 1 hour. Sign up to attend a webinar (see schedule below).

Note: Sites may only start enrolling participants into D2d once the PI has completed the eLearning module and the primary Research Coordinator has completed the eLearning module and attended a CC hosted webinar.

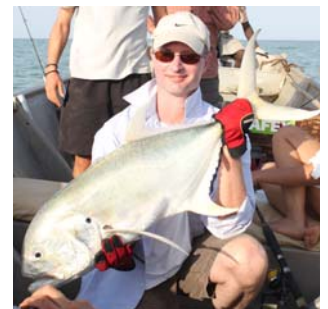
