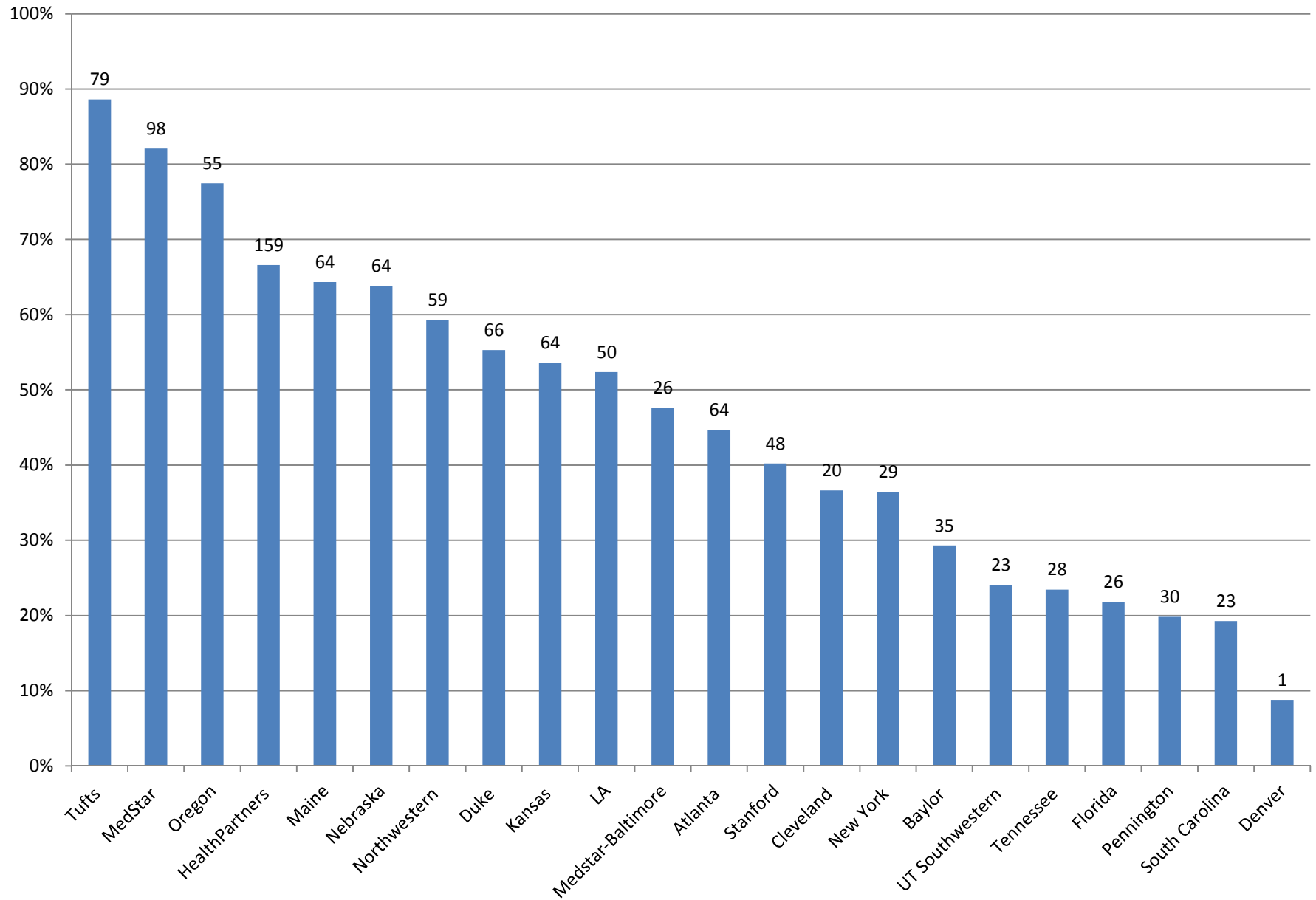

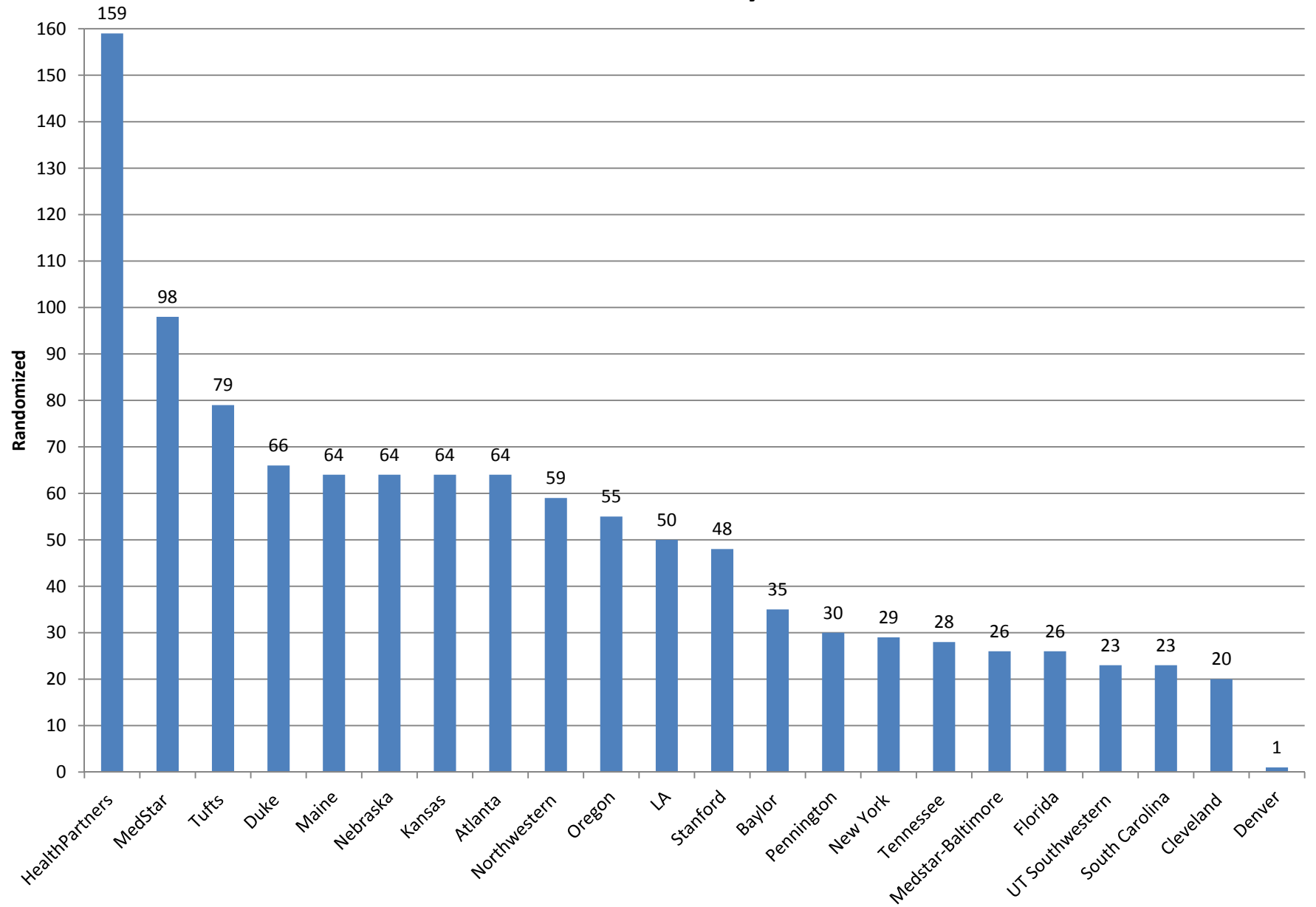

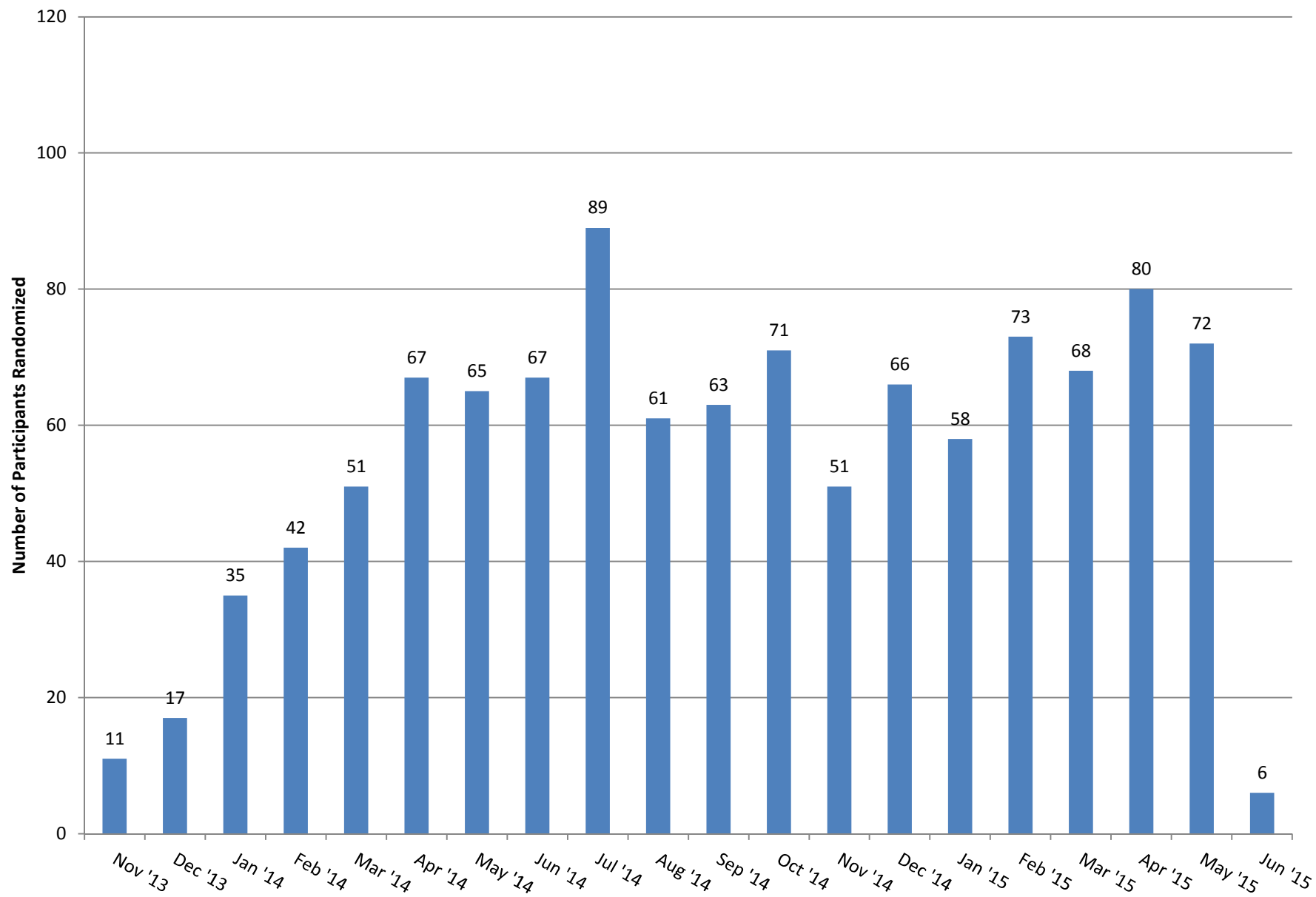
Cumulative Percent of Randomization Goal Achieved Through June 3rd



Randomizations by Site



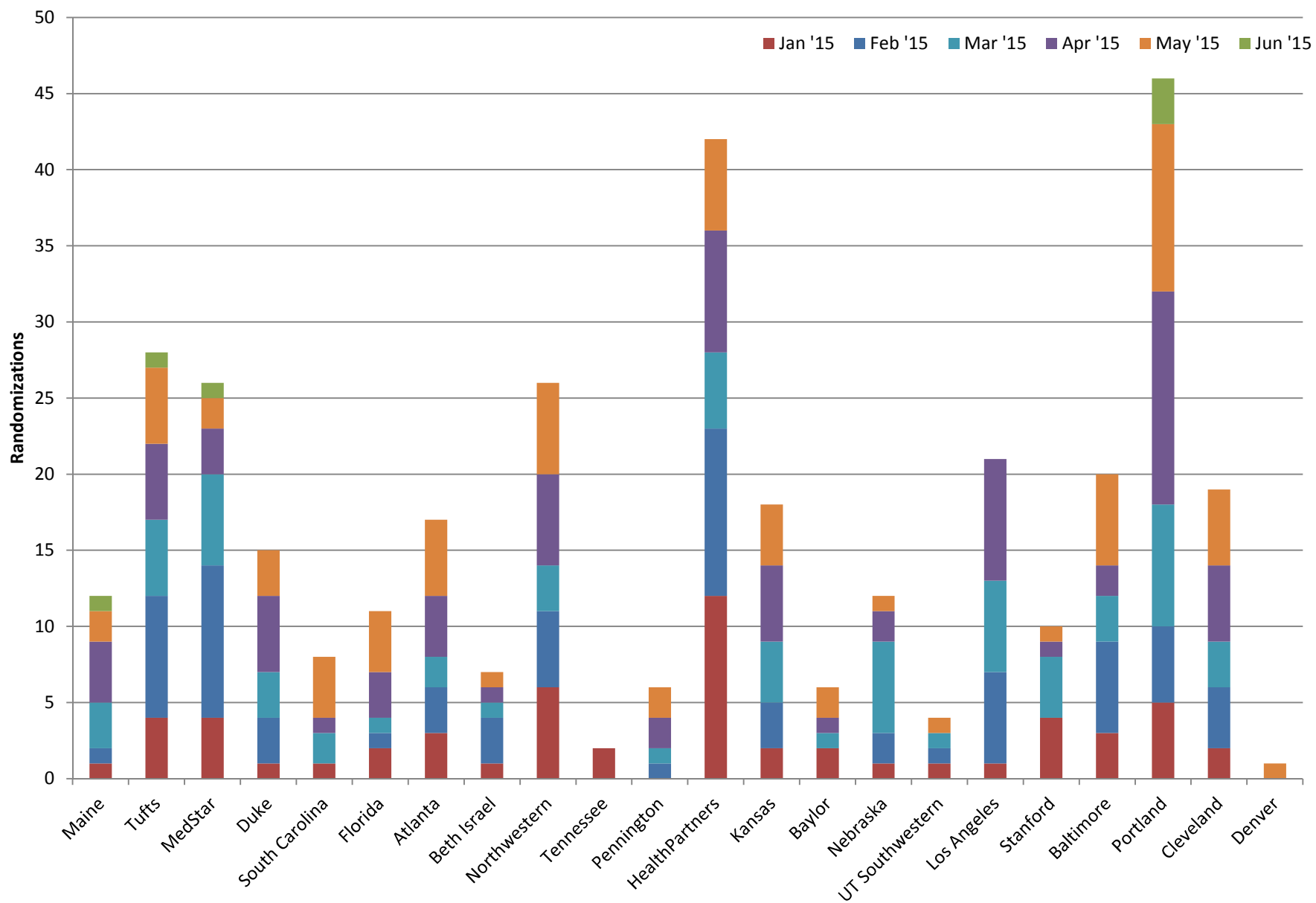
Study-Wide Randomizations per Month



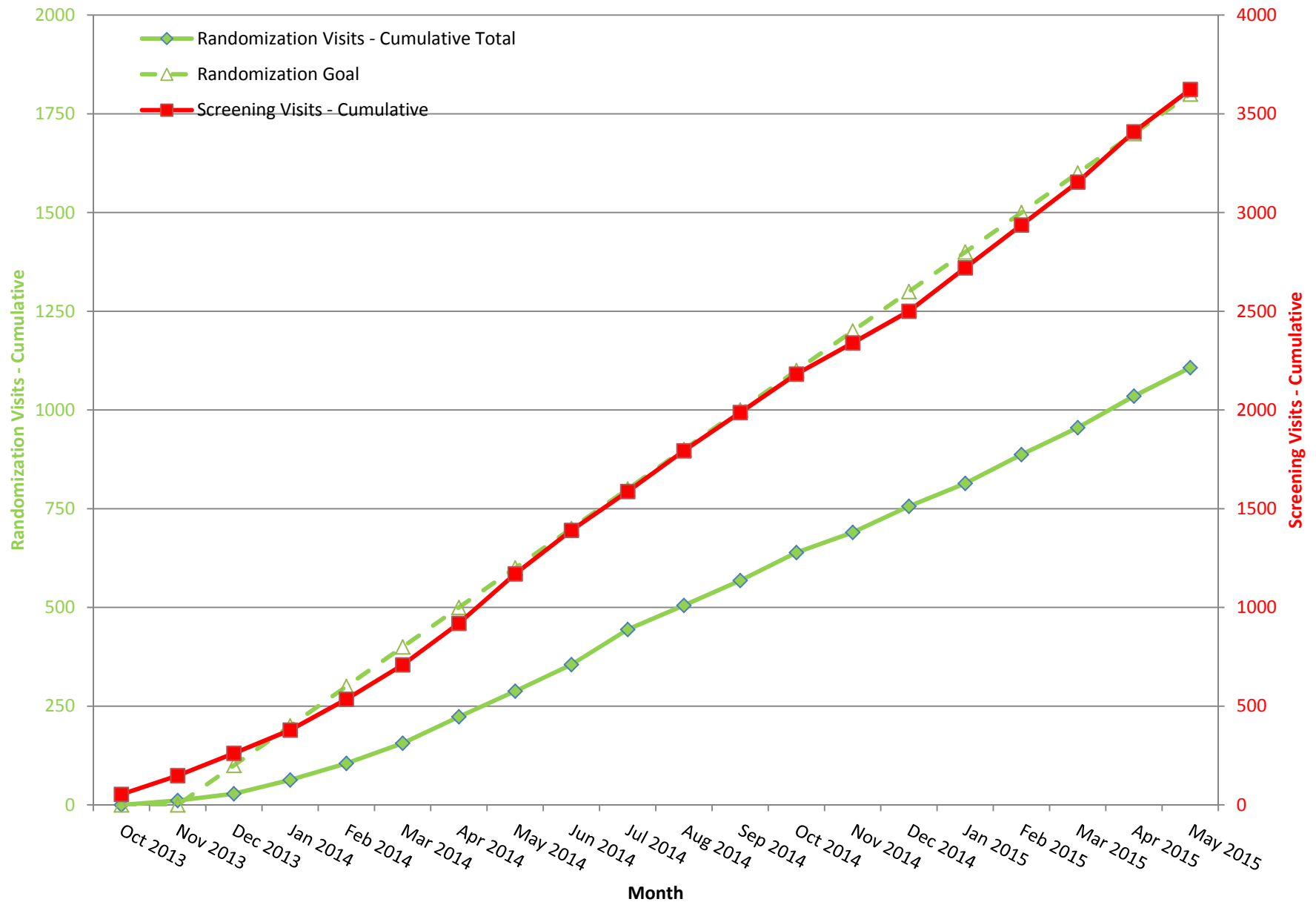

Randomizations By Site - Last 6 Months

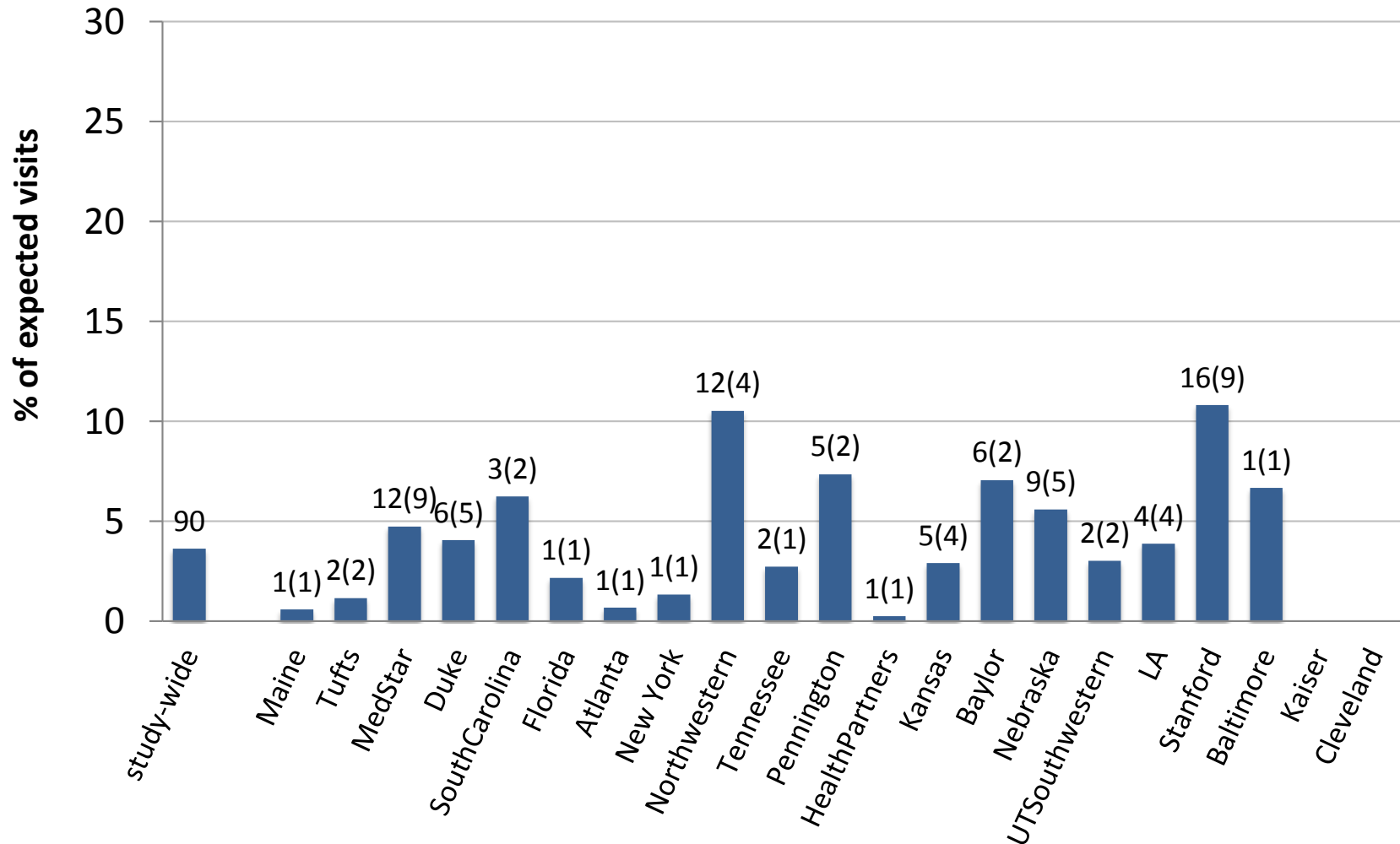


Cumulative Screening and Randomization Visits by Month
