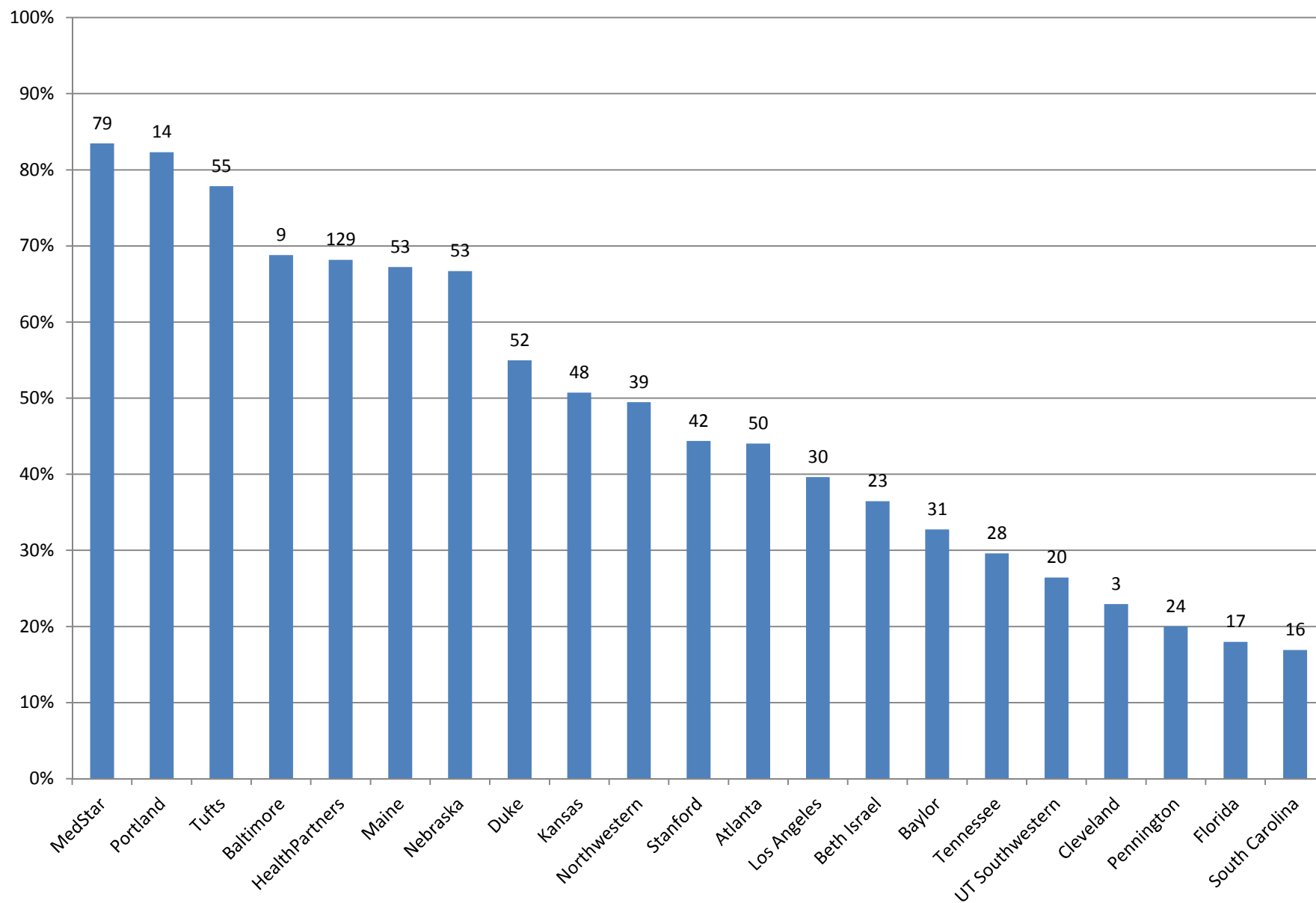

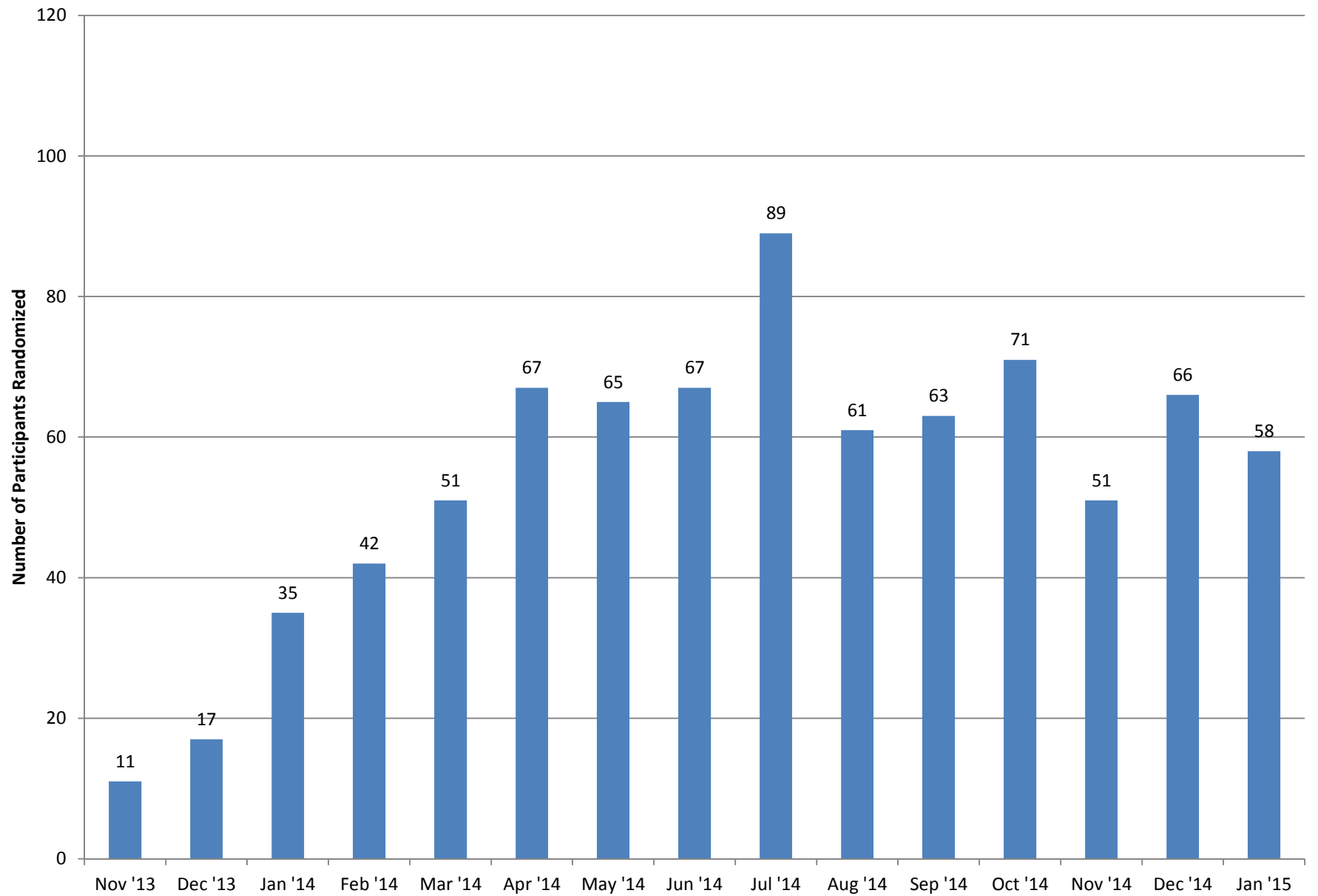

Cumulative Percent of Randomization Goal Achieved Through February 4th



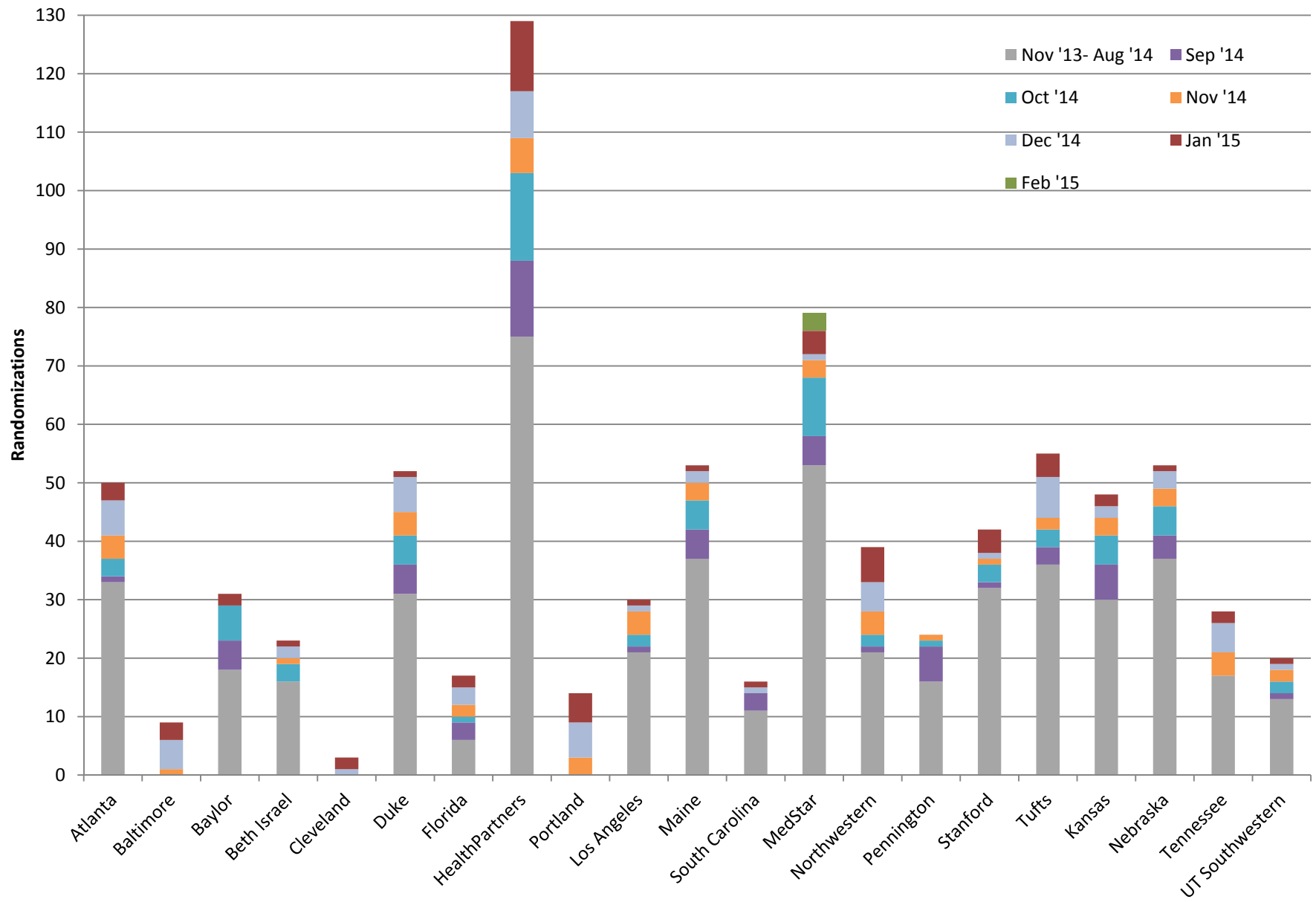
Study-Wide Randomizations per Month



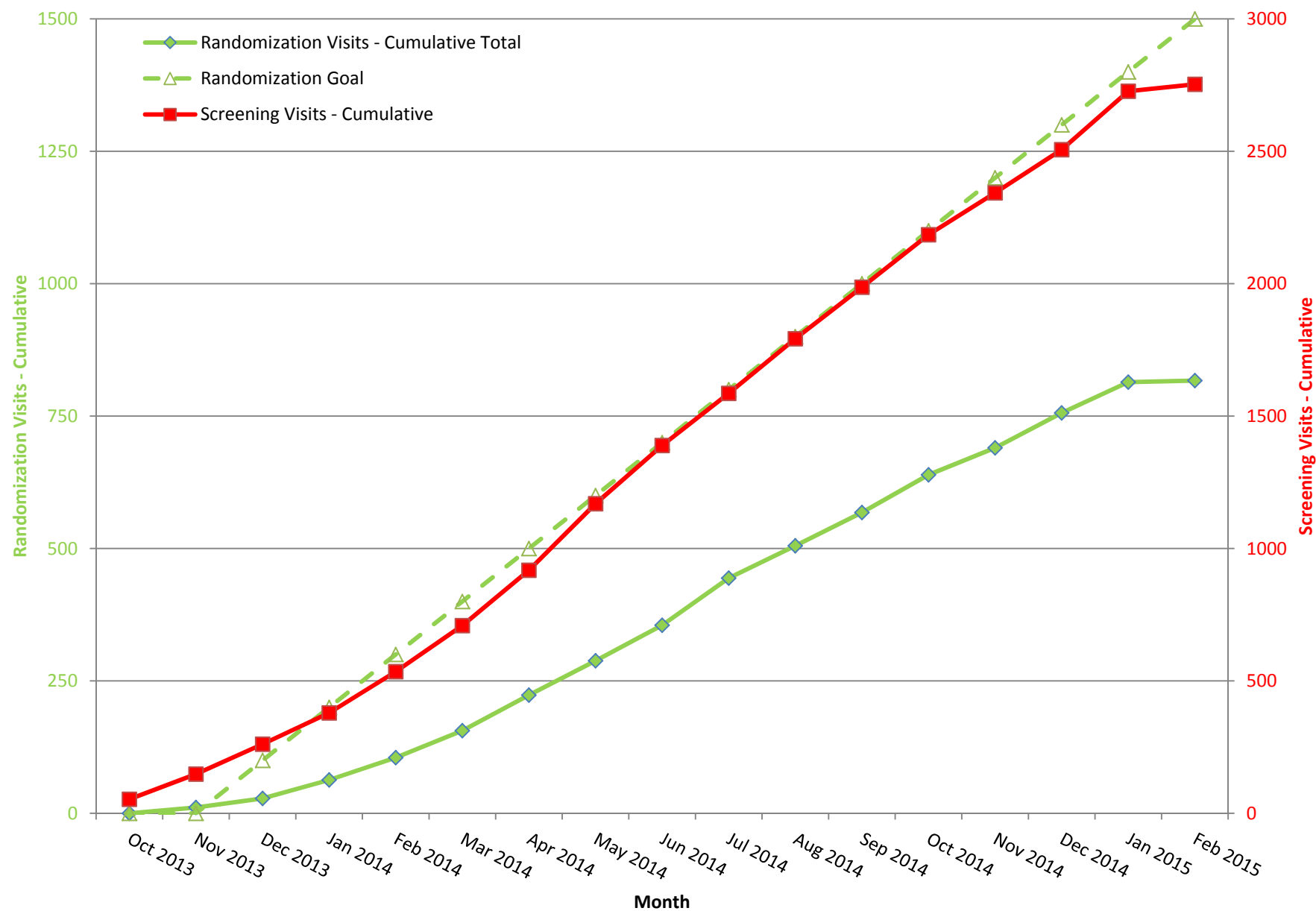

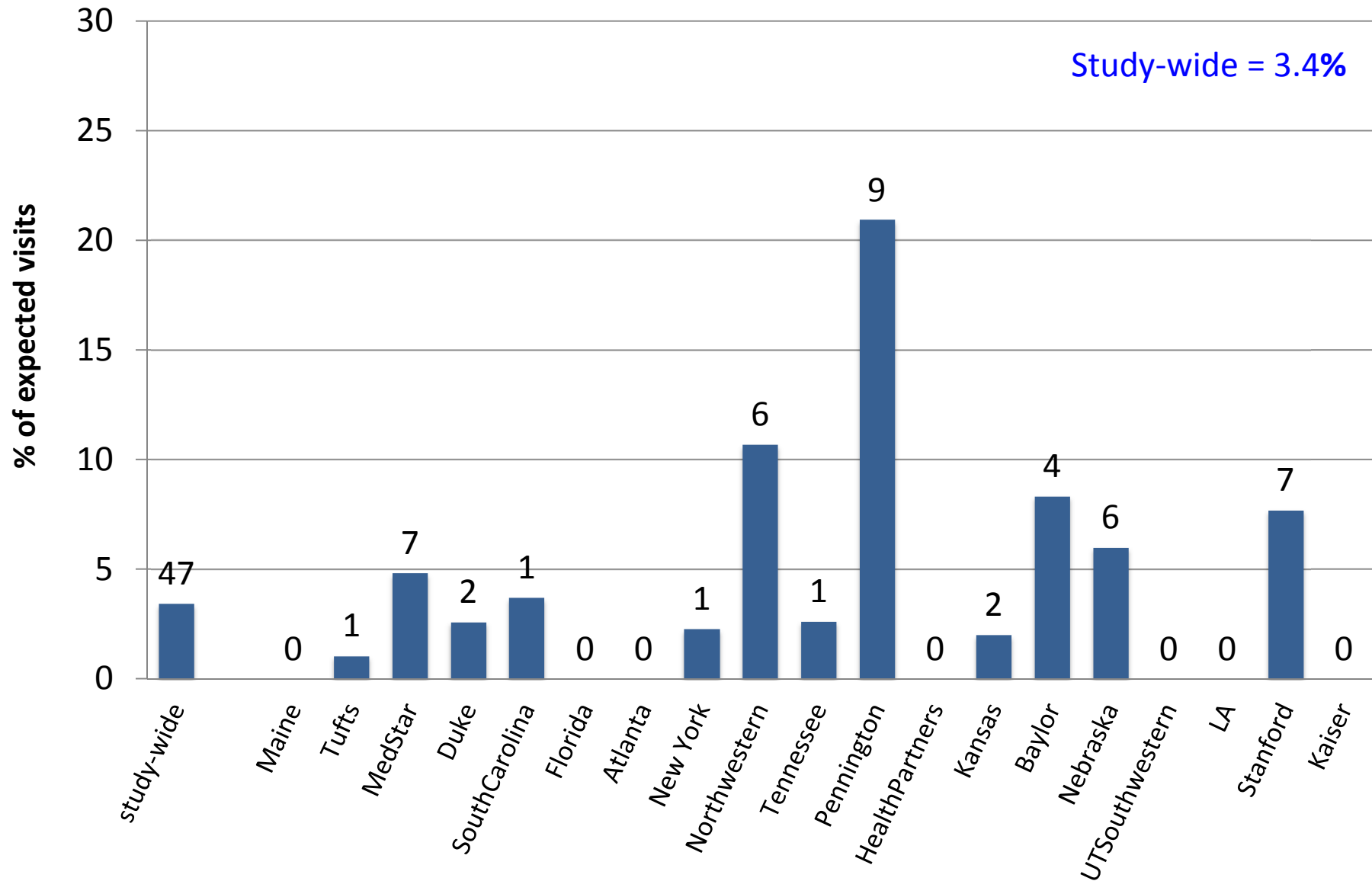
Randomizations By Site
