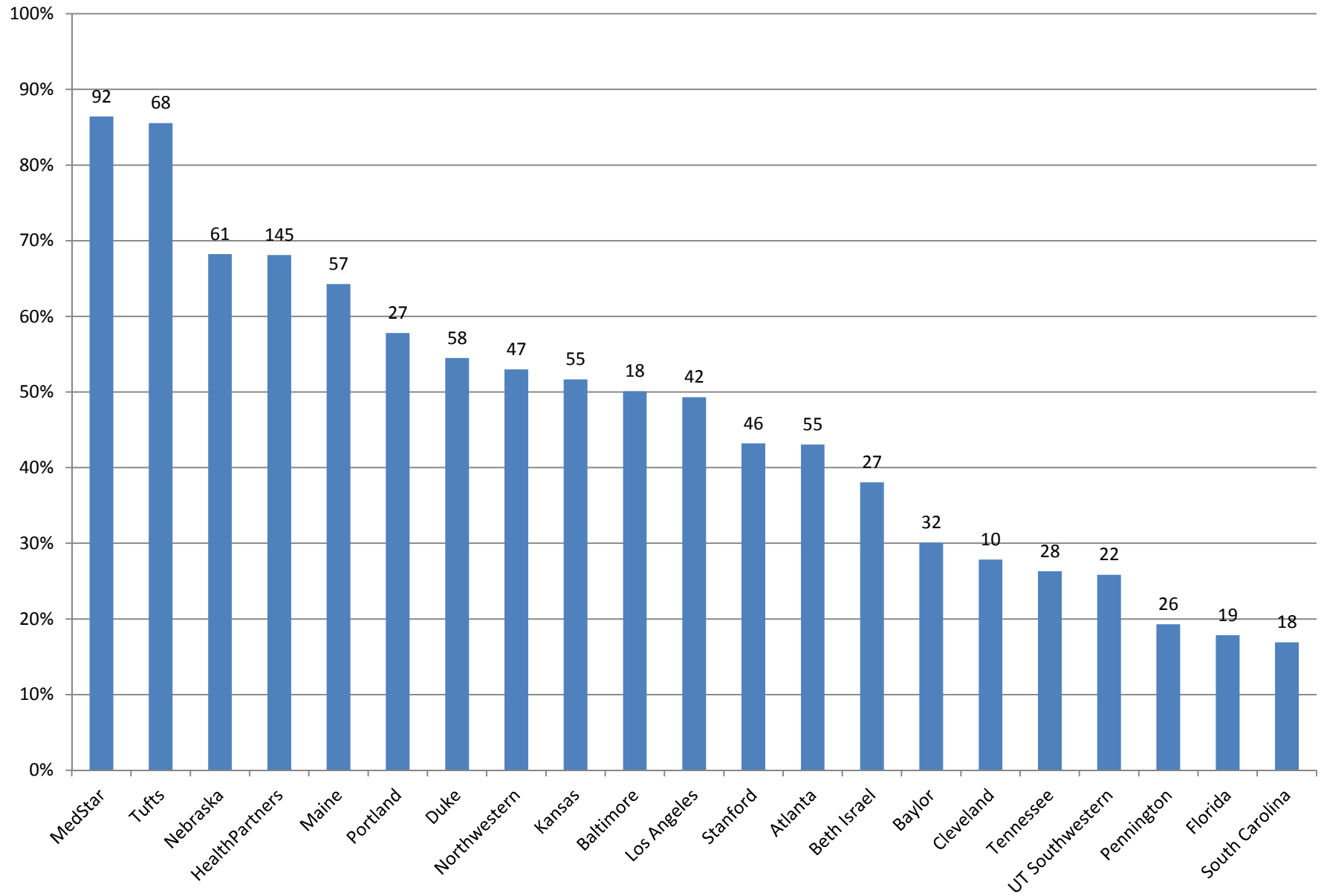

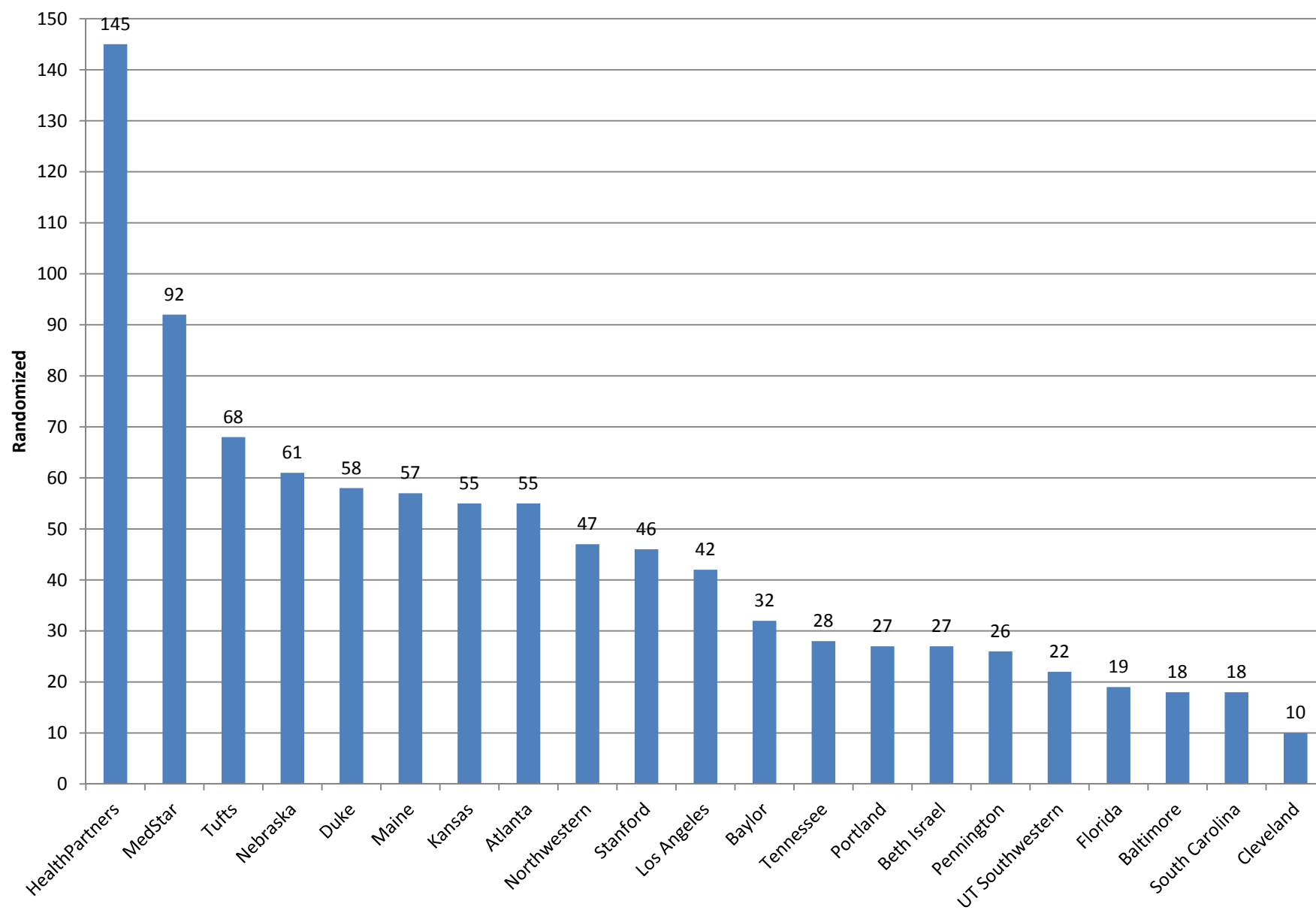

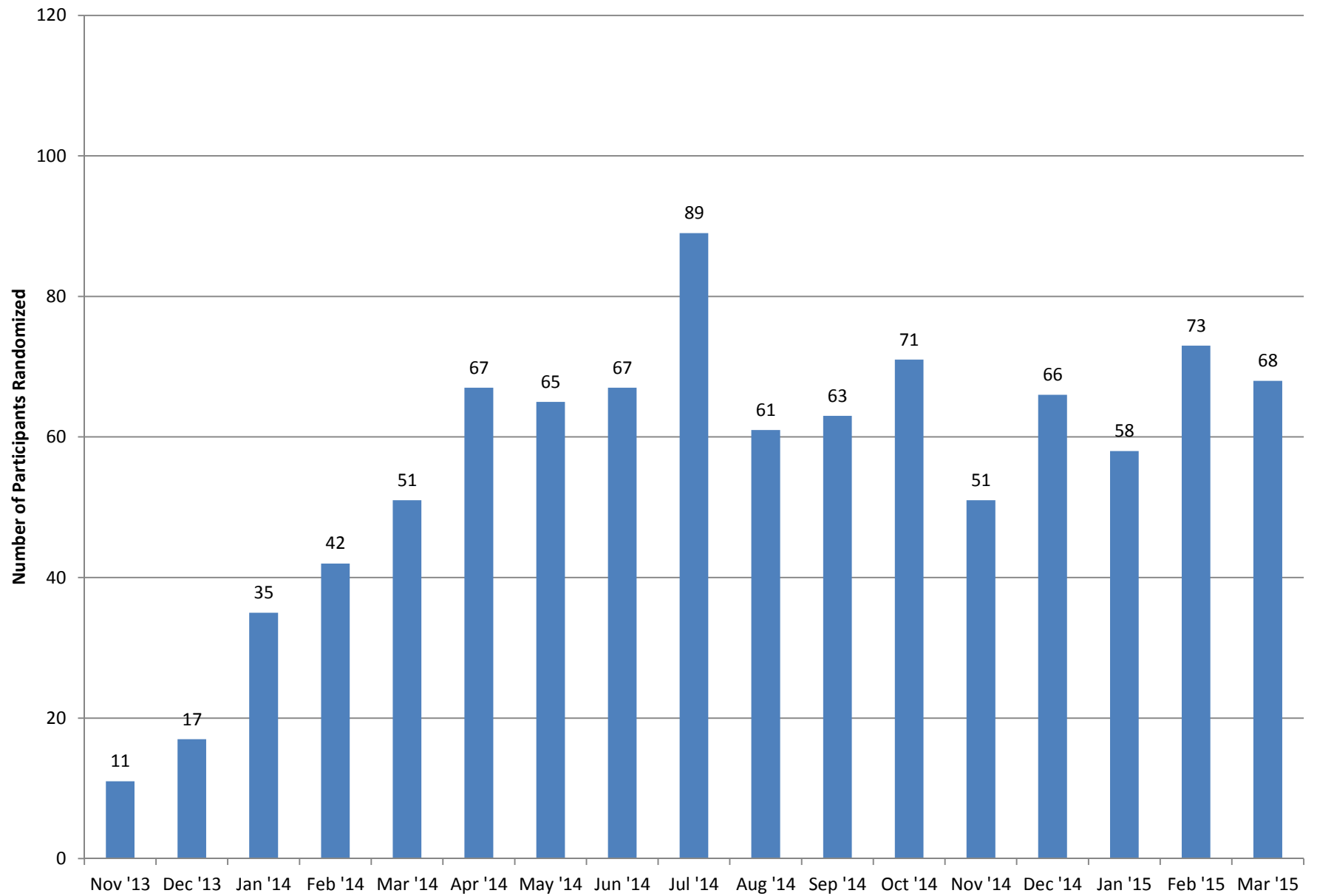
Cumulative Percent of Randomization Goal Achieved Through April 1st



Randomizations by Site



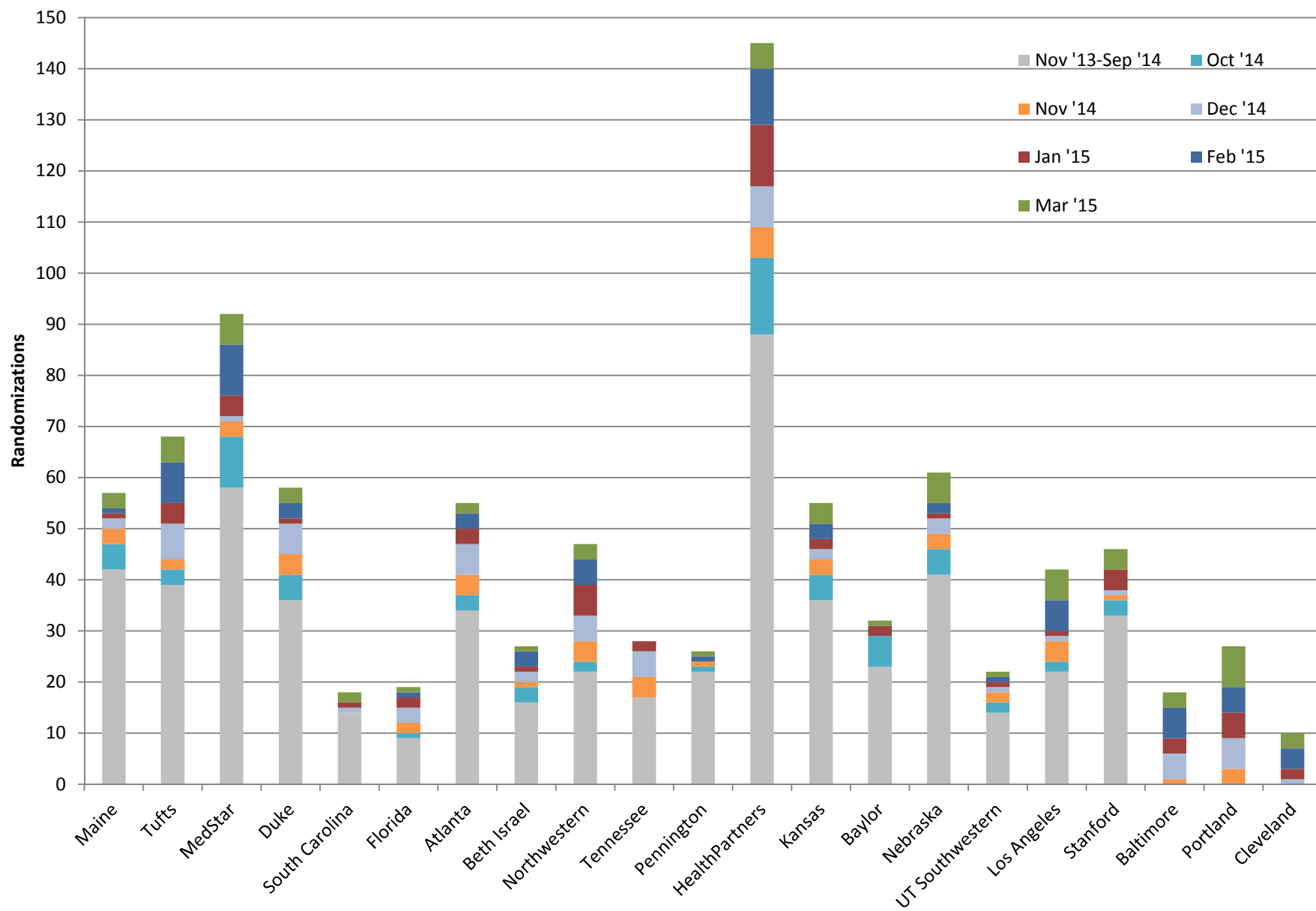
Study-Wide Randomizations per Month



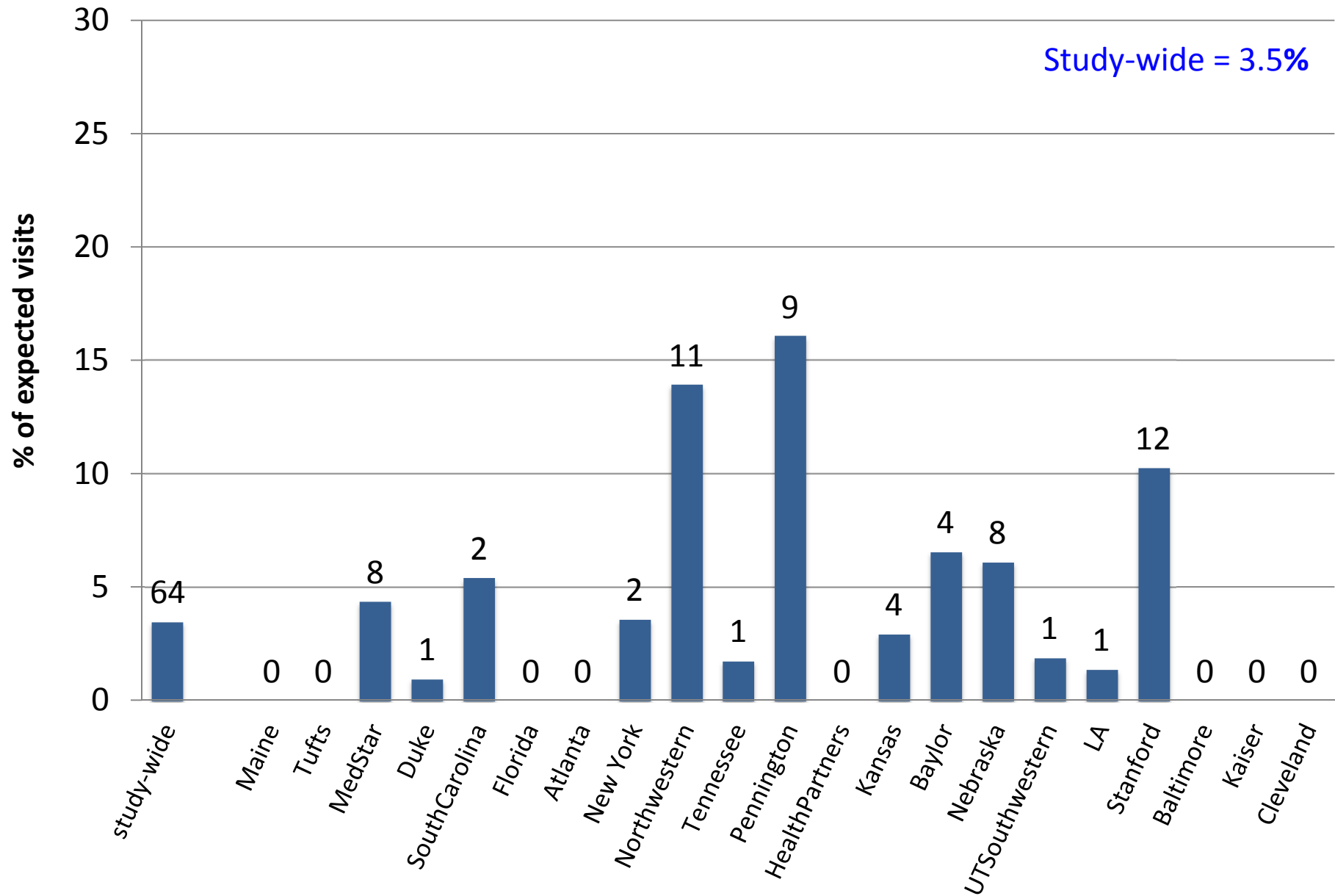
