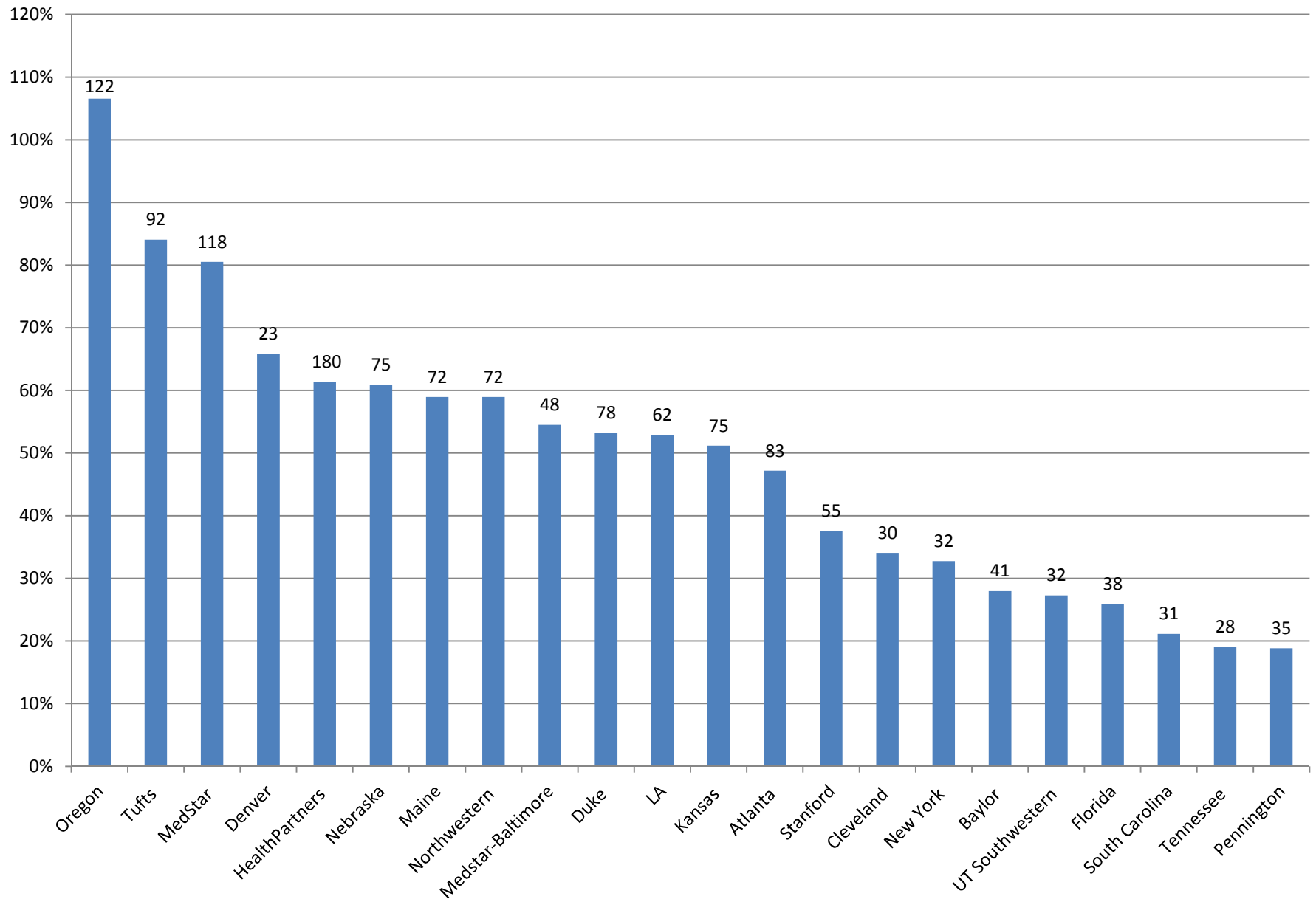

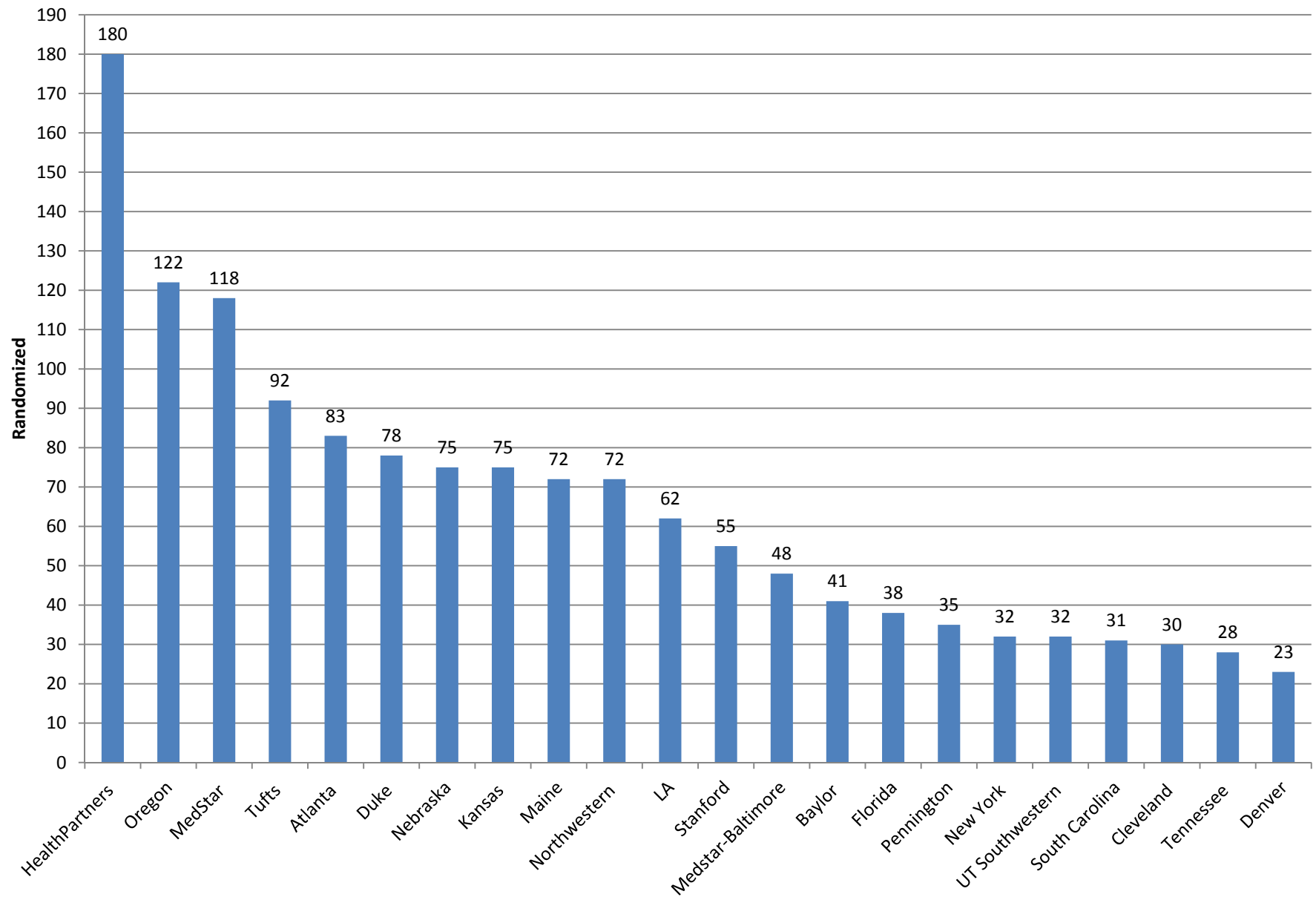

Cumulative Percent of Randomization Goal Achieved Through October 14th

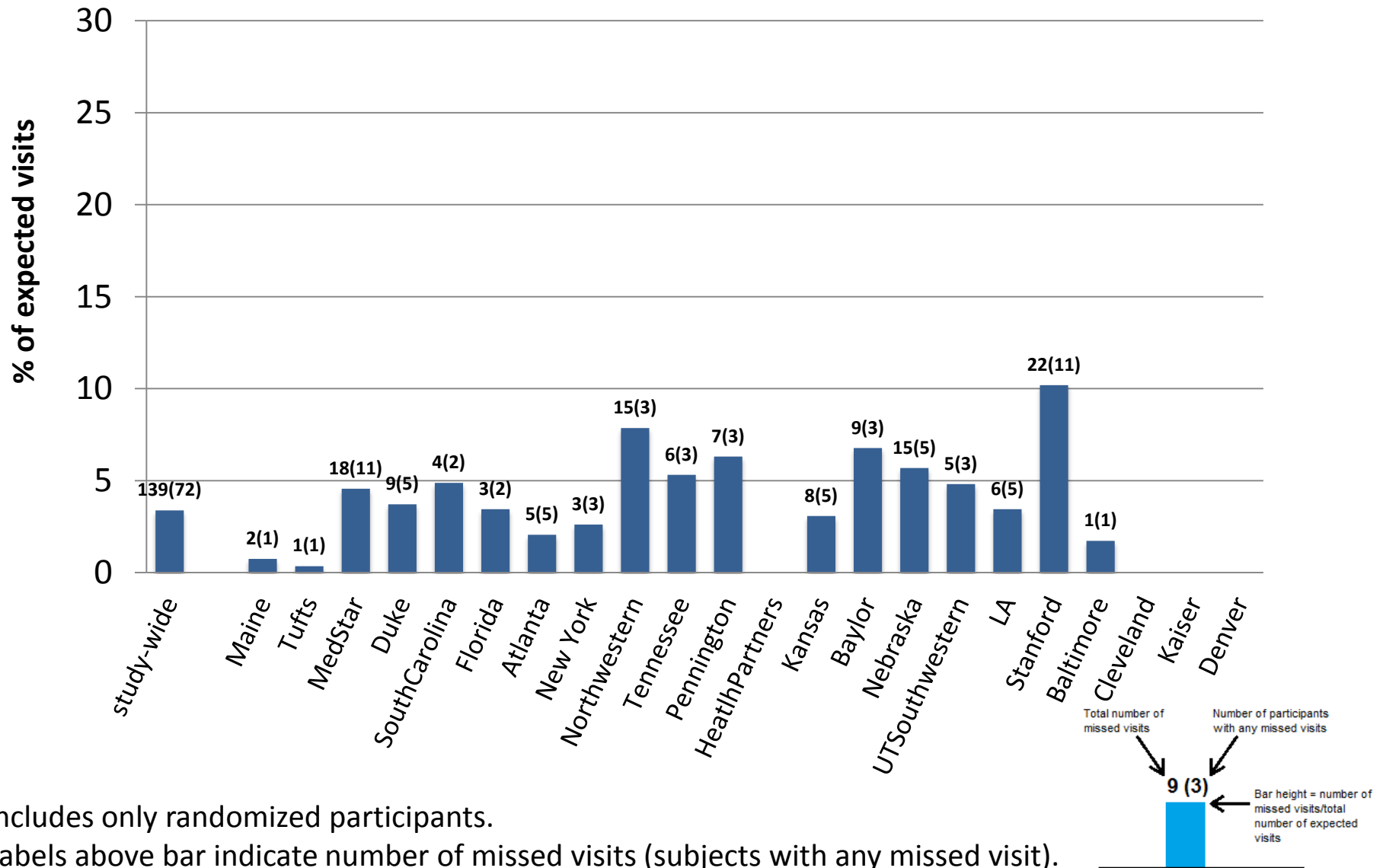


Randomizations by Site



Missed visits, (% of expected visits)

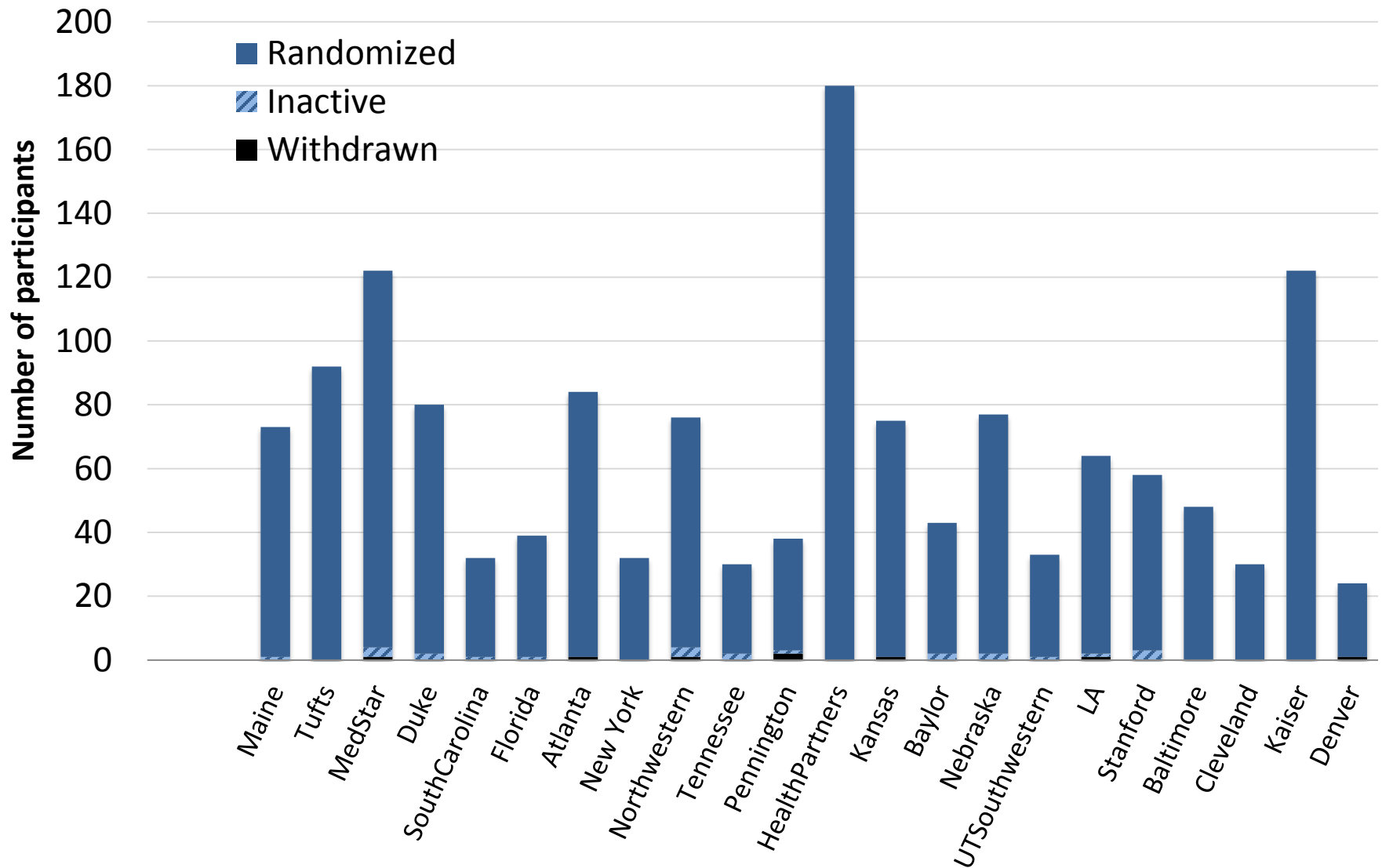

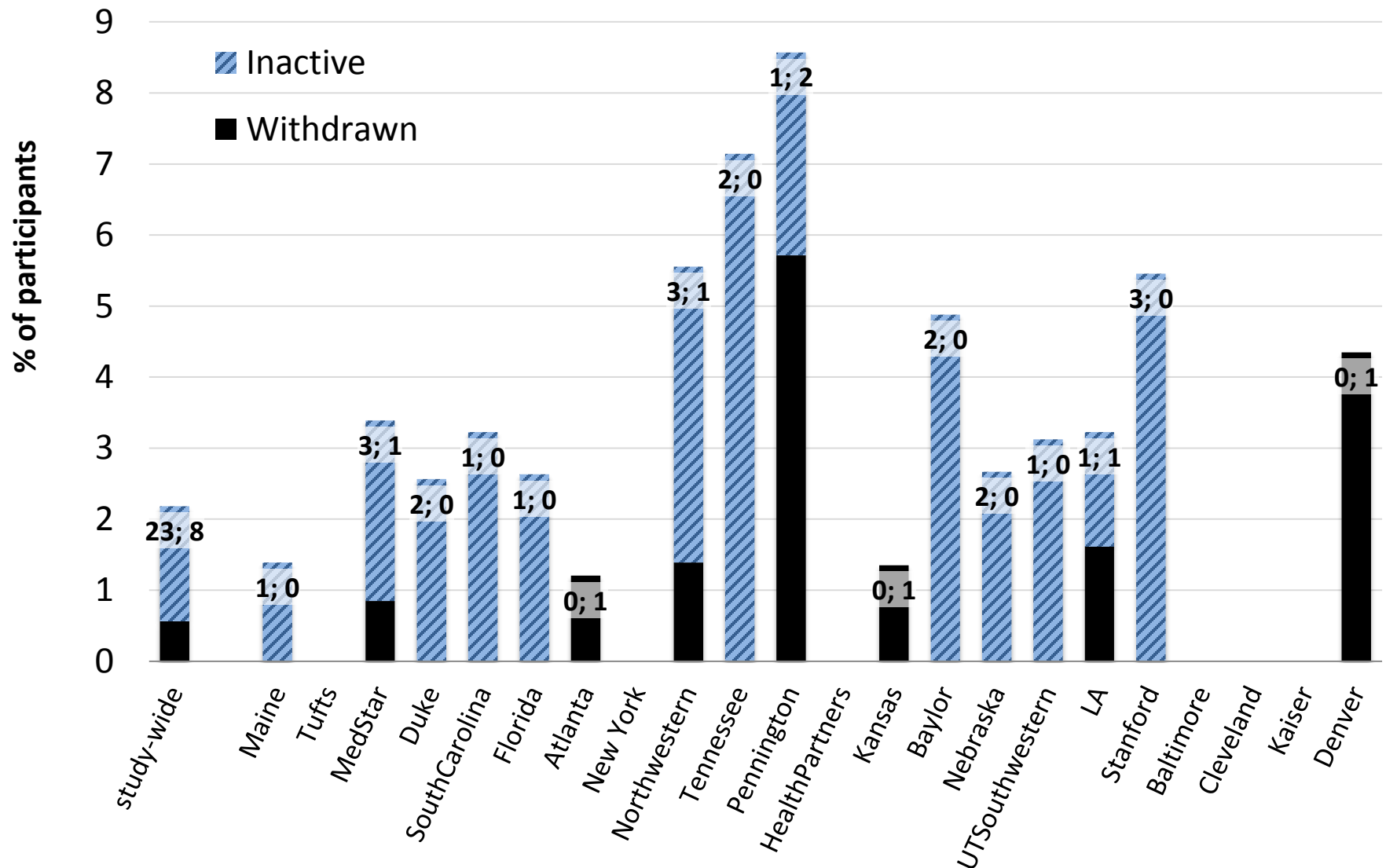

Number of inactive and withdrawn participants



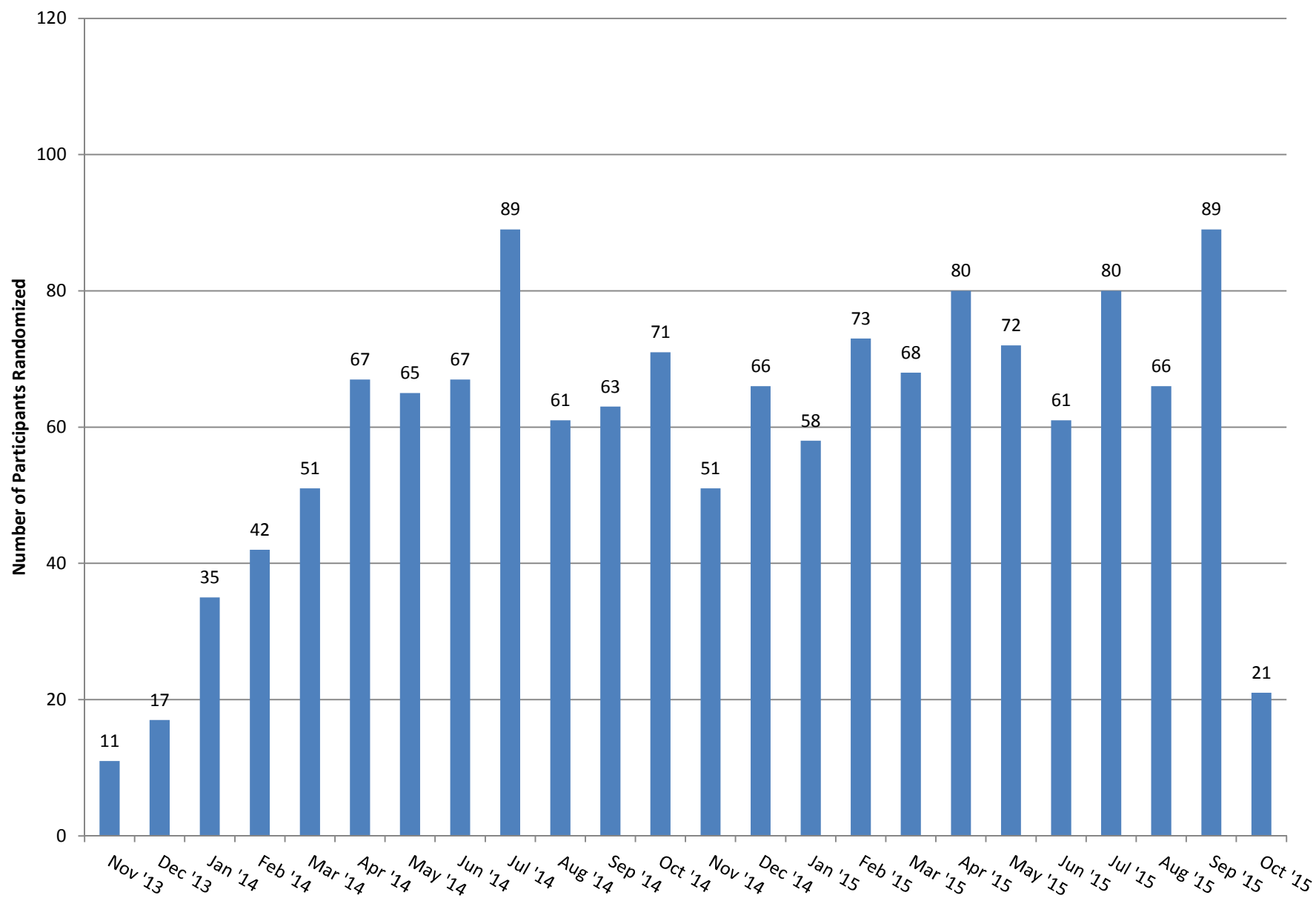

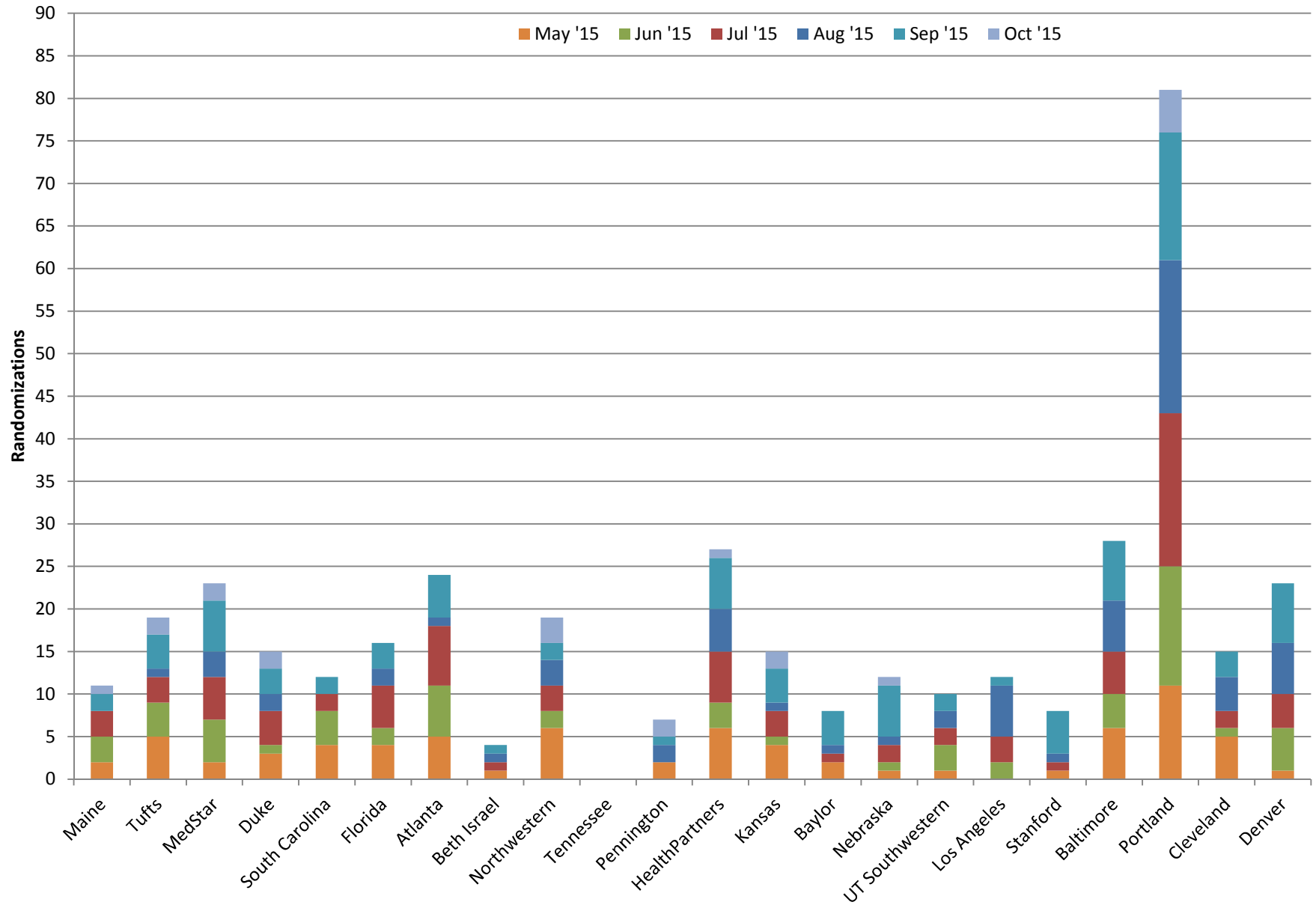
Study-Wide Randomizations per Month



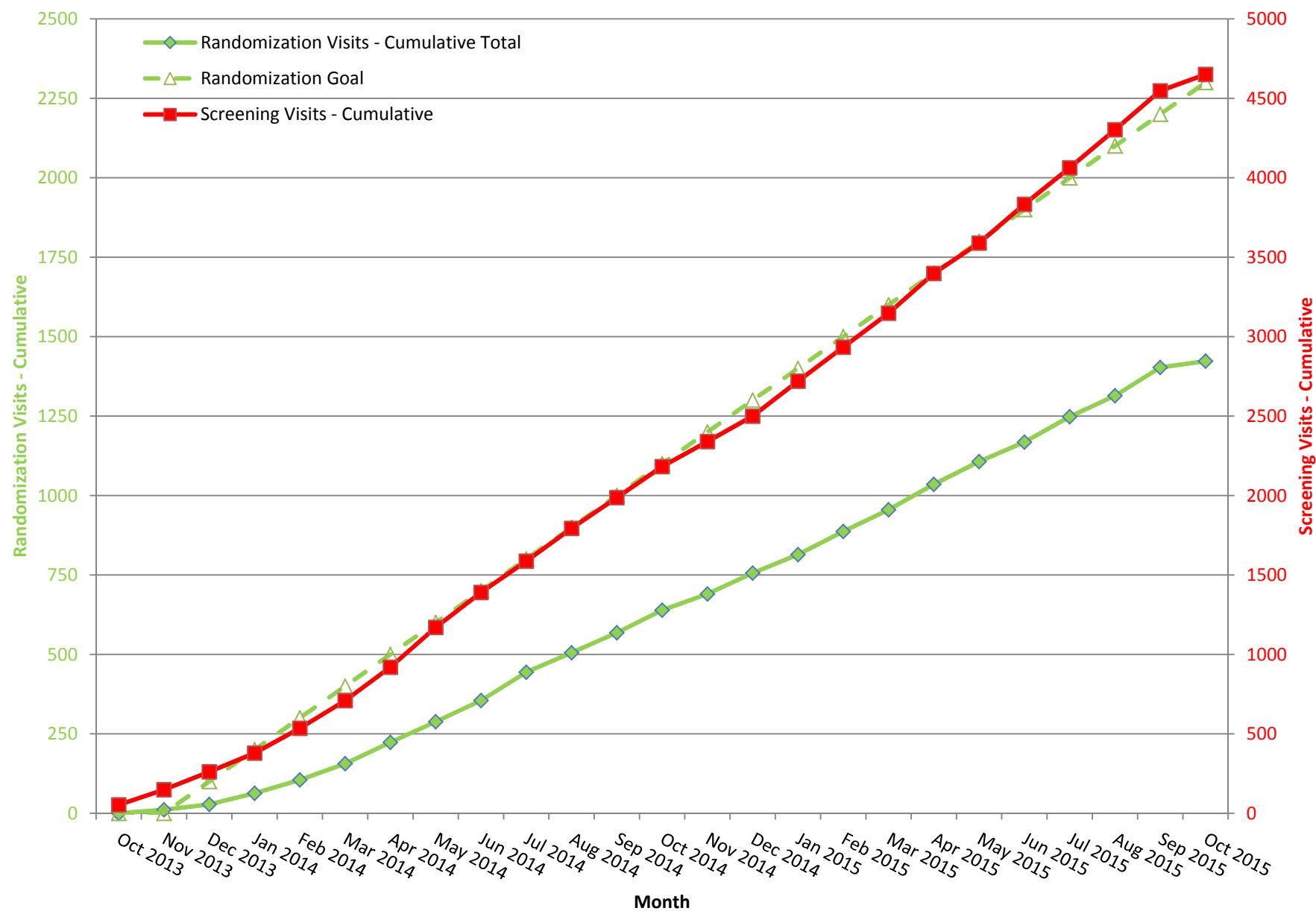
