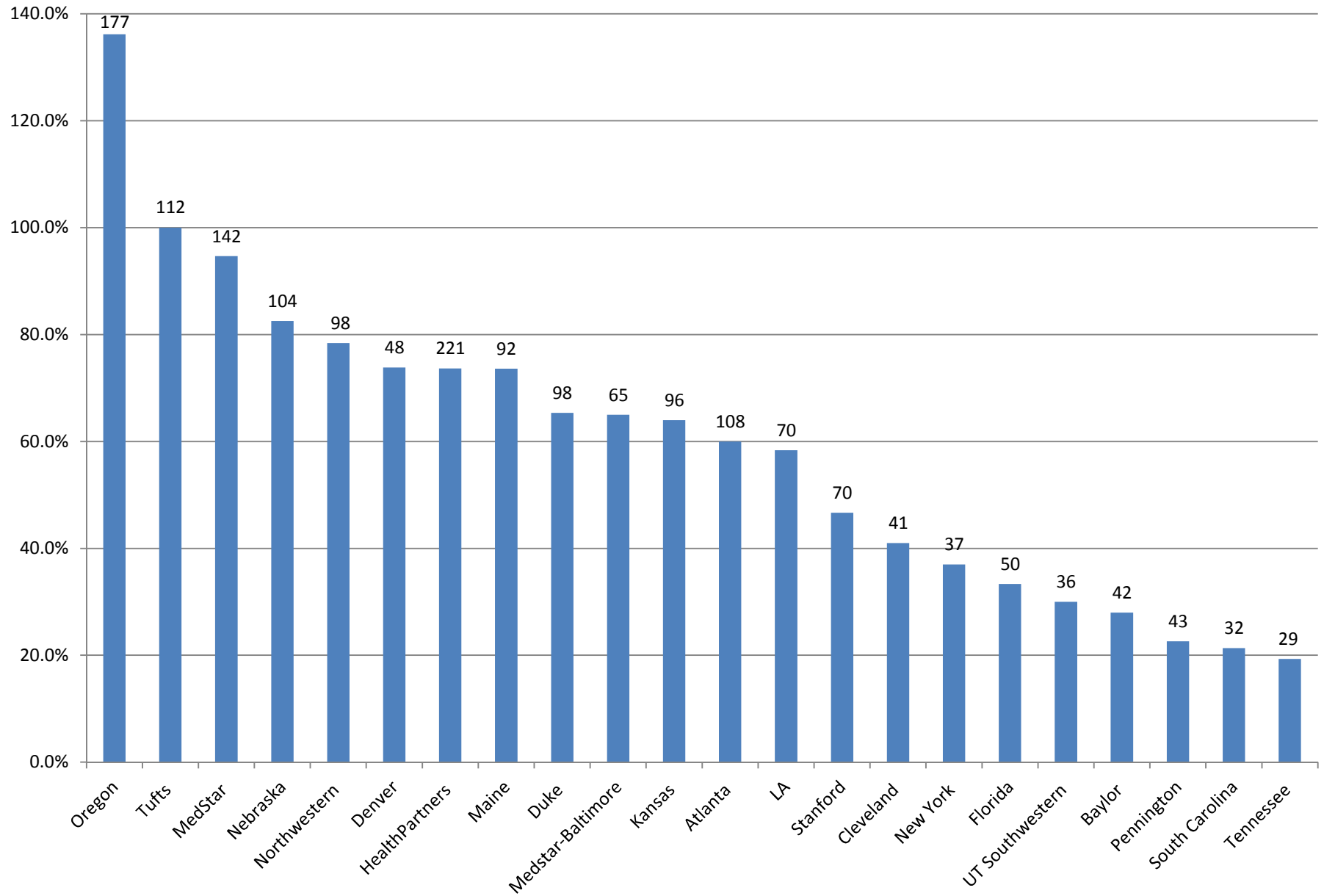

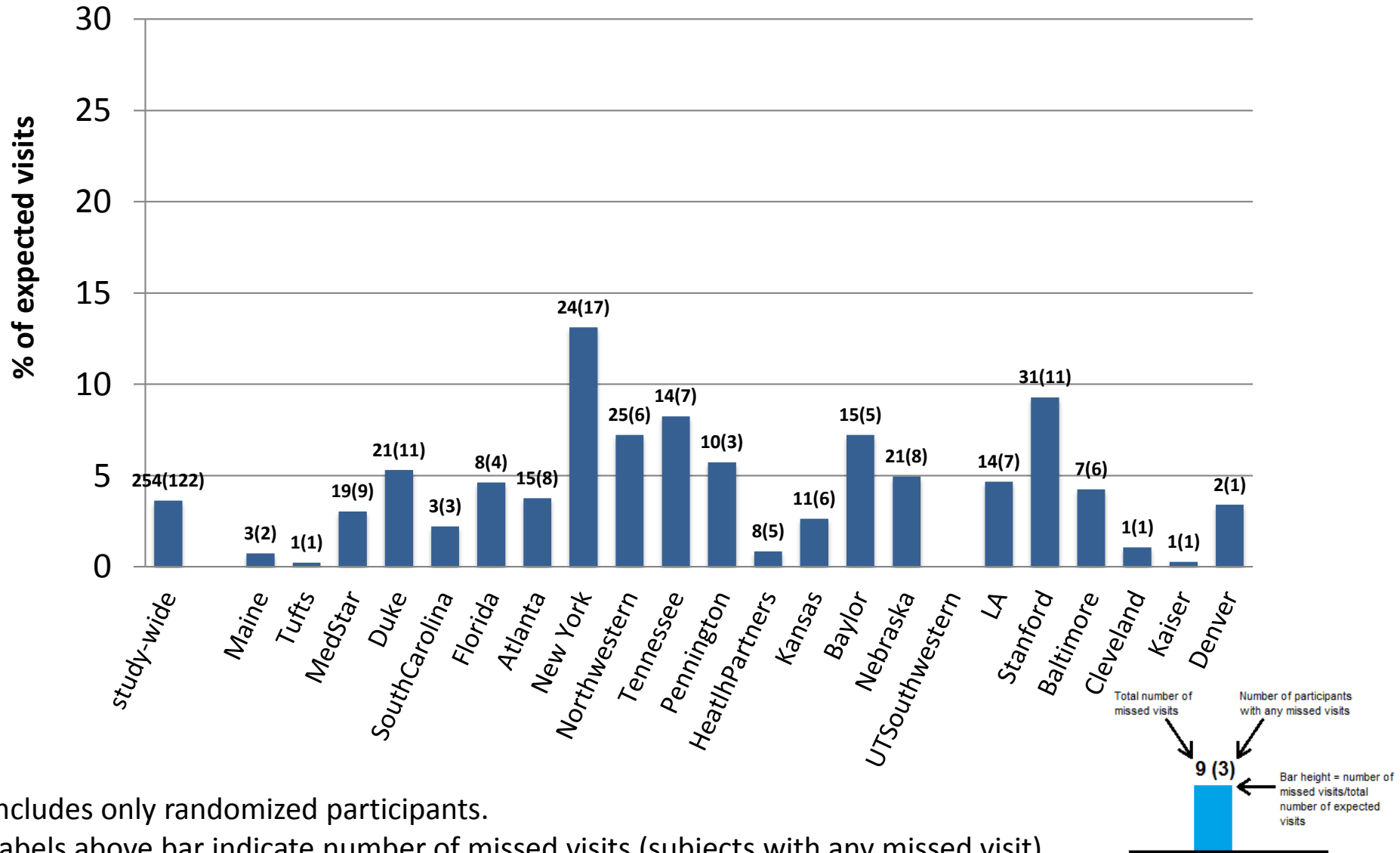

Missed visits

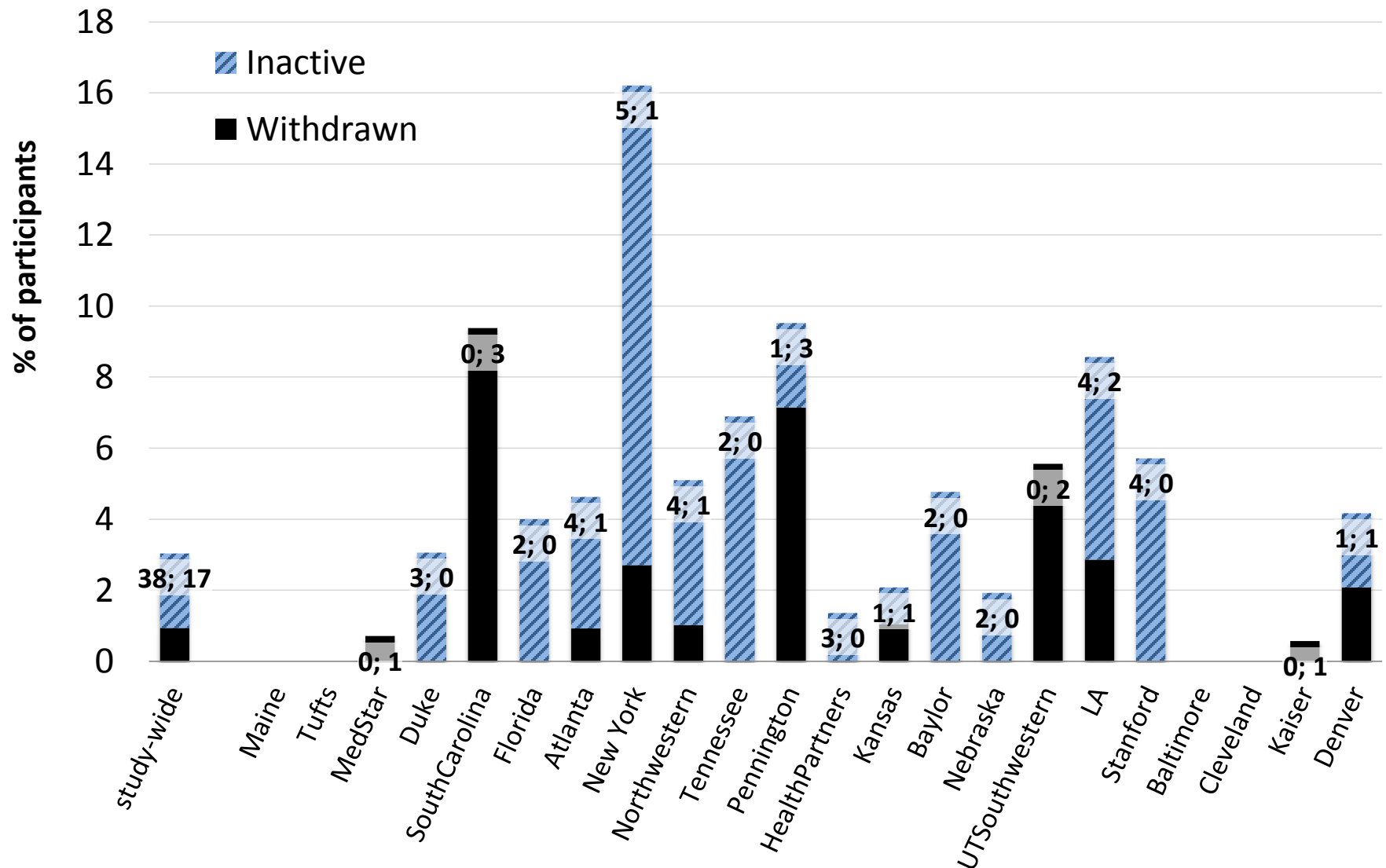

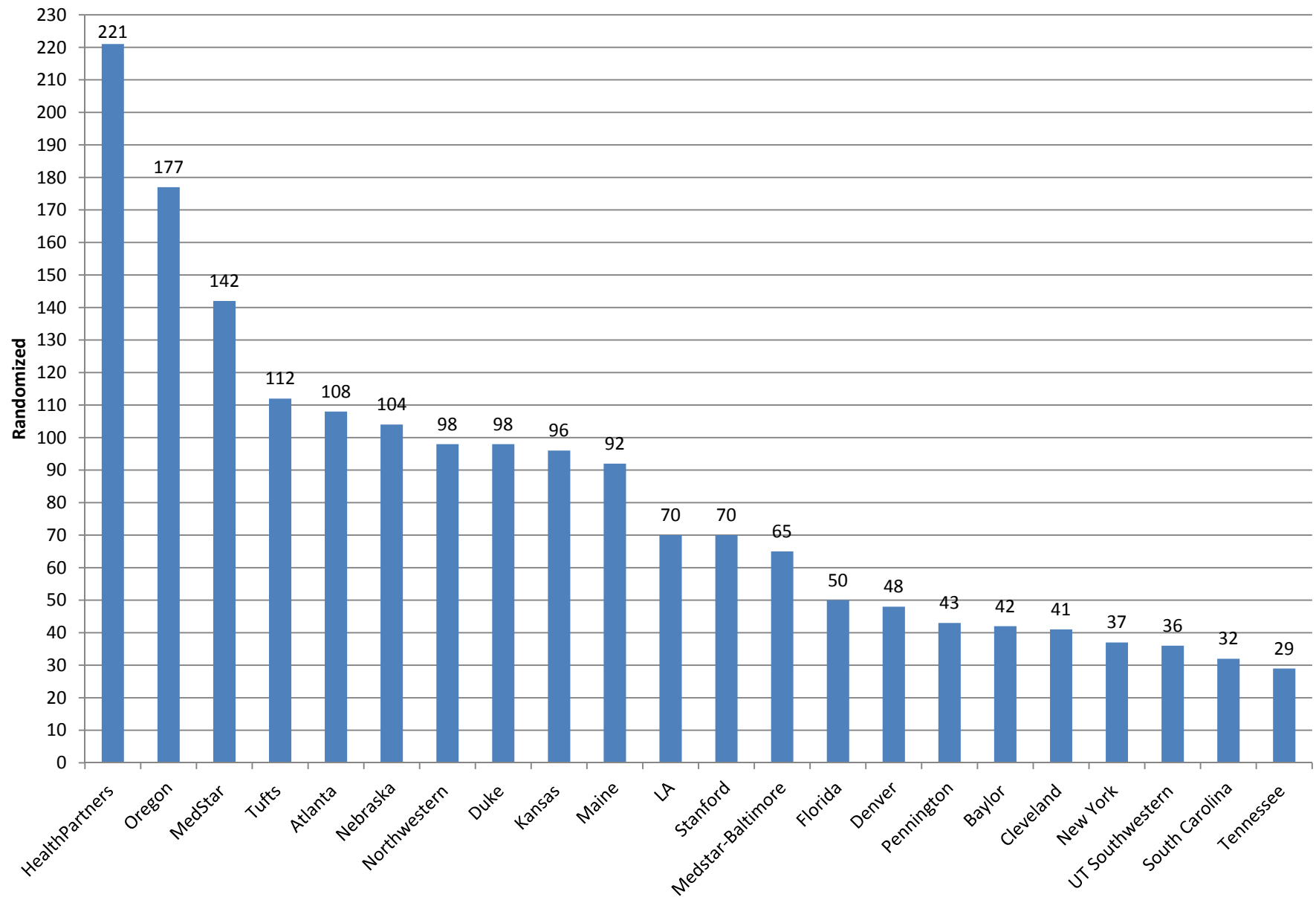

% inactive and withdrawn participants

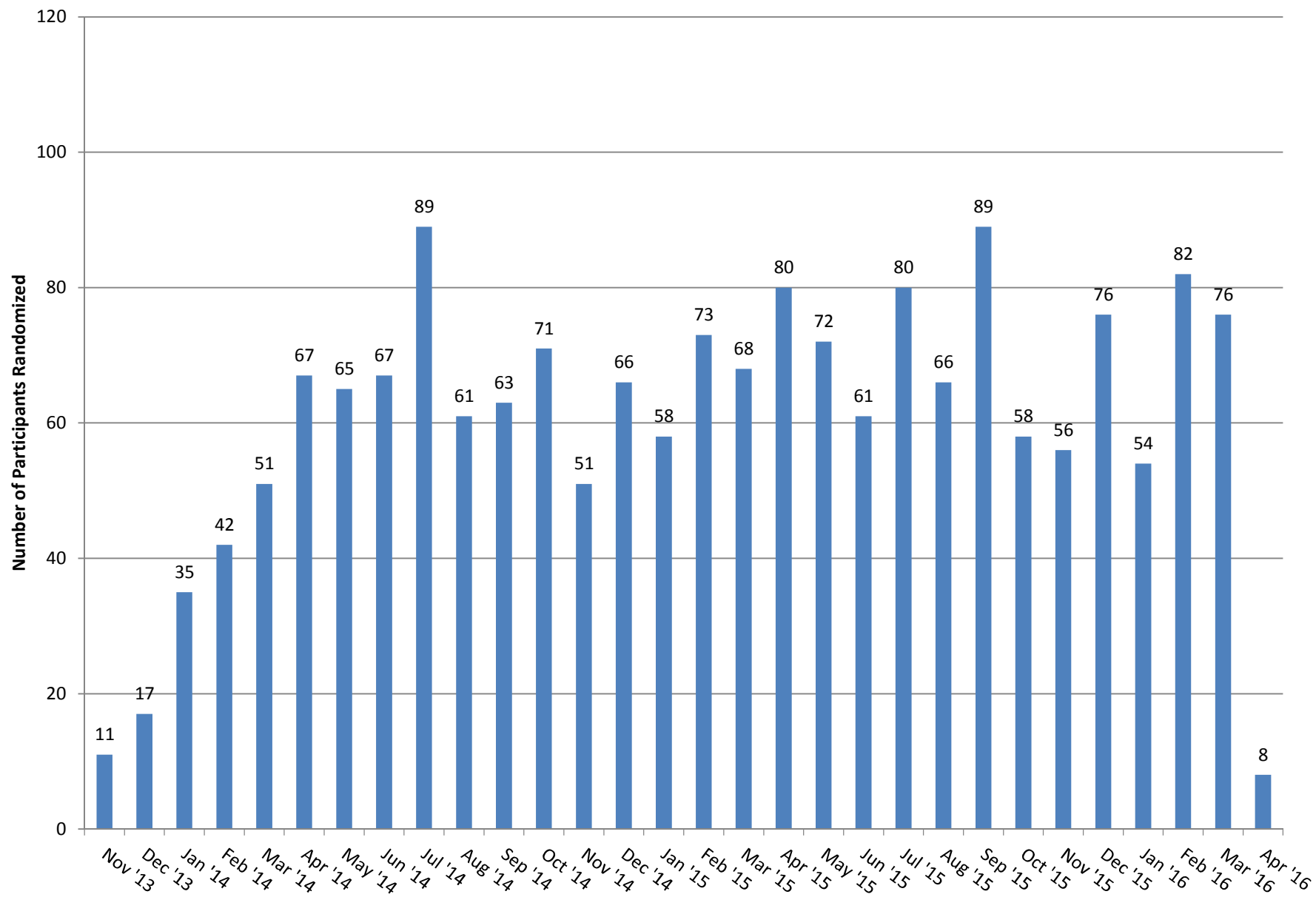

Randomizations by Site



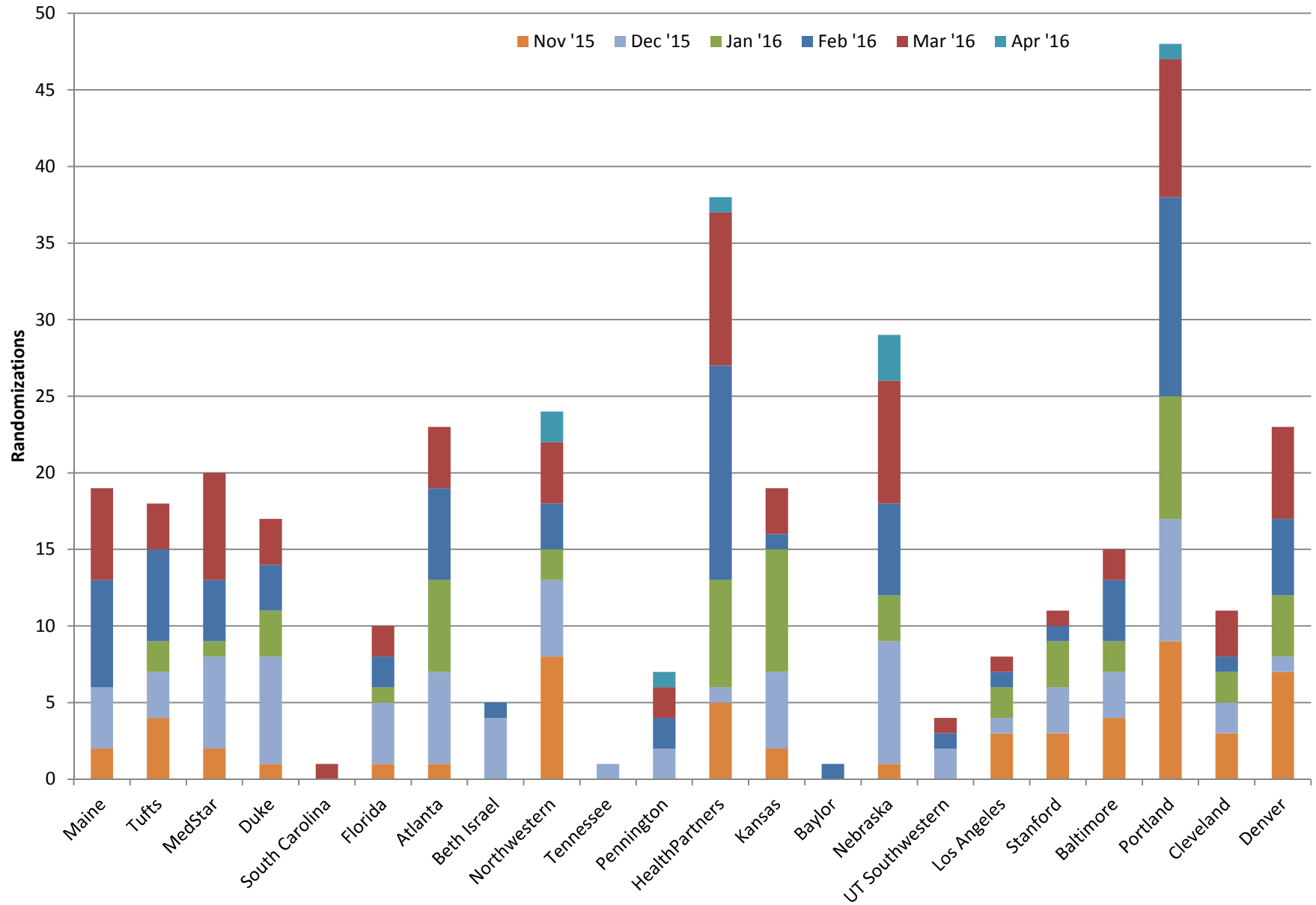
Study-Wide Randomizations per Month



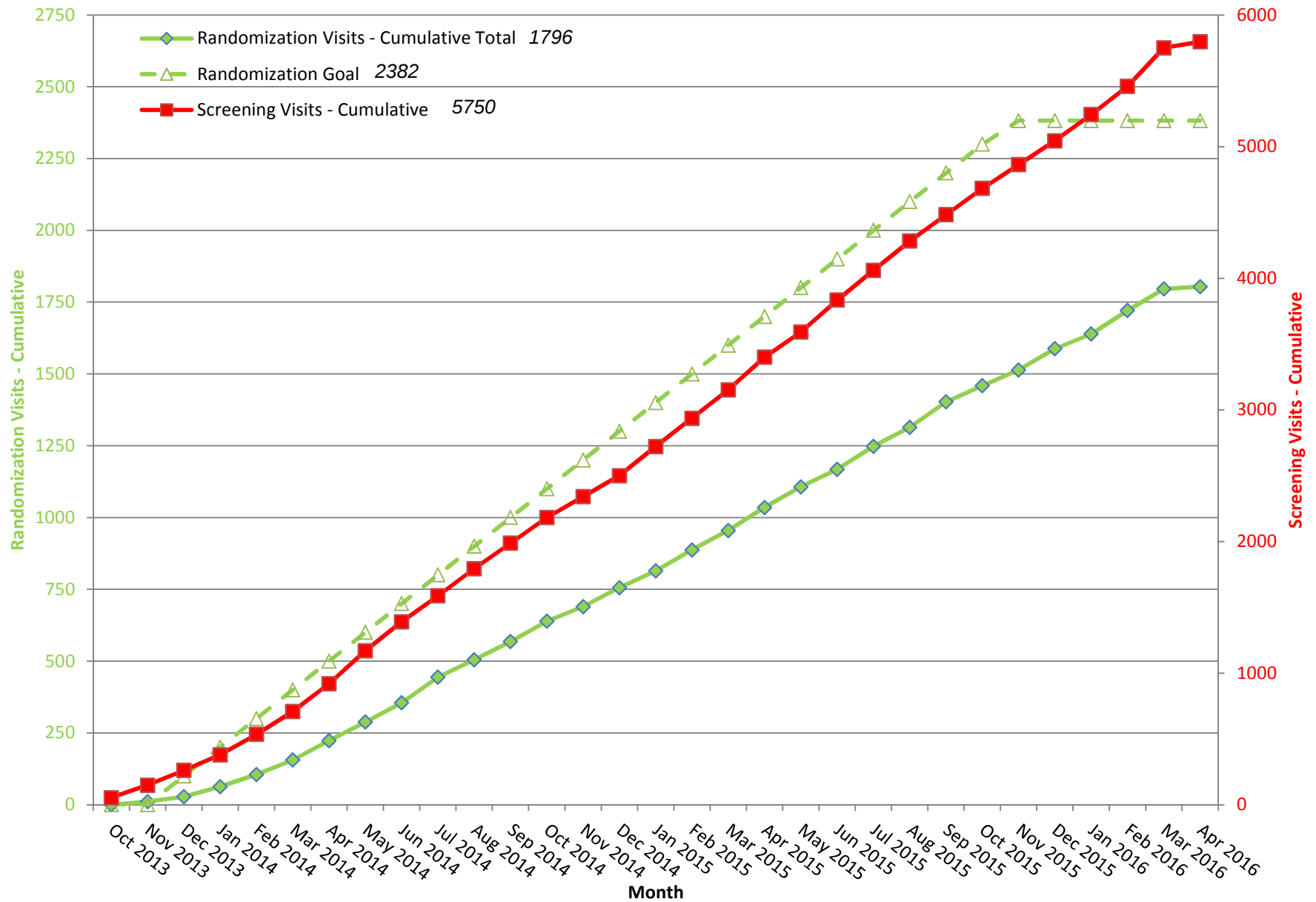
