Committee Updates

- **PPS:** Michael Lewis's paper on the *Management of hemoglobin variants detected incidentally in HbA1c testing* was accepted for online publication in Diabetes care. Dr. Aroda, Dr. Brodsky and Dr. Desouza are leading writing groups.

Q.O.L Assessment in D2d

- A Q.O.L task force was developed to review the questionnaires, goals of the questionnaires and prepare a recommendation at this month's meeting.
- The SC reviewed the Q.O.L task force summary/ plan and suggested developing a protocol/ safety plan for "at risk" patients that all sites can refer to.
