D2di

- Sites have received the D2di supplement materials (interim protocol, ICF template, & amendment letter) and many have already submitted to the IRB.
- D2di will not extend the D2d study but it permits sites to conduct up to 2 more phone encounters after the last scheduled visit in D2d. The intent of the supplement is to keep participants engaged for up to an additional 6 months after their last in-person visit while planning for the future of D2d/D2dOS.
- Participants will be asked to continue taking the study pills and sites will continue to collect AEs, diabetes outcomes, & non-diabetes outcomes data.
- The supplement does not add burden to the site staff.

Future of D2d

- On March 1, Taso presented to NIDDK the study's progress and plans for extending D2d (D2d Outcomes Study, D2dOS).
- NIDDK cannot accommodate the extension of D2d under a U01 grant model. However, an avenue to continue D2d would be through multiple R01 grants.
- NCI is interested in providing funding for an extension of D2d. Taso will explore further and will keep everyone up-to-date.

Action: SC committee members are encouraged to share/discuss any ideas by emailing Taso.

Other Outcomes Update

- Committee reviewed cancer screening/cancer diagnoses entered in EDC across all sites (page 7). Almost all sites have submitted or entered an event in EDC. The CC is working with sites that haven't done so.
- 578 cancer screening/cancer diagnoses have been entered in EDC, and 554 records have been sent to the CC.
